

Subject: BC Art Collection

Colleagues,

As you may be aware, the BC Art Collection program loans BC artist's work to government offices in Vancouver and Victoria. The collection was established in 1974, contains over 1,100 works by 400 artists, and is valued at \$3.2 million.

Artwork is typically provided to Ministers' and Deputy Ministers' offices.

We have received some inquiries from elected officials and senior government staff regarding the collection and the process to borrow the artwork.

- 1. A request is made to the Arts and Cultural Development Branch (Kris.Andersen@gov.bc.ca).
- 2. Viewing of the work at the secured vault will be scheduled.
  - \* Artwork is chosen by the requesting office.
- 3. Coordination with administrative staff regarding delivery of the artworks and appropriate care in the requesting office.
- 4. There is no fee to borrowers but borrowers pay for a contracted fine art handler to deliver and install the loans. The cost for installation usually ranges between \$200 and \$500 dollars depending on the size of the selected artworks.
- 5. Loans will be limited to 5 per office.

Subject: First Nations Leaders Gathering Info

Colleagues,

We are quickly approaching the 4<sup>th</sup> annual BC Cabinet and First Nations Leaders' Gathering (the Gathering), scheduled for Wednesday, September 6<sup>th</sup> & Thursday, September 7<sup>th</sup> at the Vancouver Convention Centre. There will be a networking session and reception on September 5<sup>th</sup>. It is strongly recommended that Deputies attend the reception.

Planning is well underway. Below you will find information to aid your preparation.

#### Overview of the Gathering

The Gathering is an opportunity for First Nations Leaders and Cabinet Ministers to directly discuss key issues and opportunities at the community level. The primary focus of the gathering will be meetings between Ministers and First Nations Leaders. Cabinet Ministers, and in some cases Deputy Ministers, will host one-on-one meetings over the two days of the Gathering. The Gathering will also include a series of speakers along with remarks from the Premier, the MIRR Minister, and leadership of the First Nations Leadership Council.

Agenda discussions are underway with the First Nations Leadership Council. More information will be provided to your office later this summer. The Gathering will be discussed at a Cabinet meeting. We will provide materials to Deputies and Ministers for that meeting.

#### One-on-one Meetings

A "save-the-date" was sent to First Nations leaders in April with the opportunity to respond early with requests for one-on-one meetings. MIRR will schedule the one-on-one meetings based on requests from First Nations, and will frequently be in contact with your Ministry. We will provide you a schedule of meetings and topics as information becomes available. The completed list of meetings will be available prior to the gathering, but we anticipate that many meetings will be scheduled at the Gathering itself.

In situations where Ministers are oversubscribed, one-on-one meetings may be scheduled with the responsible Deputy Minister or Parliamentary Secretary. Similar to the UBCM convention, meetings will be 15- or 30-minute increments (depending on whether the topic needs to take up two time slots).

As in previous years, in preparation for these meetings, it will be the responsibility of your Ministry to prepare any briefing materials for your Minister (no template will be provided) and to identify a scribe from your Ministry to take detailed notes during the one-on-one meetings. It is important that each Ministry accurately capture any commitments made in these meetings, as they will form the basis of follow-up letters that your Ministry will be required to send out to each First Nation. These commitments will be tracked over the next year.

If you have questions regarding your meetings with a First Nation, staff from your Ministry are encouraged to call the First Nation directly. MIRR will prepare community background details for all First Nations, but any other materials for meetings are the responsibility of your Ministry. Please feel free to touch base with Shawna French in my office if you require further information. #### Follow up to 2016 meetings:

At regular intervals since last year's Gathering, MIRR has reached out to your ministries to update the status of commitments that were made during one-one-one meetings in 2016. We have received status updates from all ministries and we will continue to work with your offices to ensure any gaps are filled. The last status update has already been requested of your staff and is due to MIRR by August 1<sup>st</sup>.

#### Actions for you:

Please identify a lead contact from your Ministry and provide that name to Shawna French by August 3<sup>rd</sup>. Shawna will provide that person with information leading up to the Gathering as well as your Ministry's requested meetings to date. Before your office sends the updated commitments from last year, I ask that you review and approve your updates and ensure the outcomes are clearly articulated where possible.

Please also assign a staff member to take clear notes in the one-one-one meetings. Please provide Shawna with that person's name, title, and phone number so that they can be contacted and briefed on their responsibilities. Please also provide Shawna with the names of any other staff from your Ministry attending to support and your Ministers office staff attending. None of these people will need to register online, we will take care of that for you.

Please book your accommodation for the gathering, as September is a busy month for hotels in Vancouver. There is a hotel room block being held at the <sup>s.15</sup> held until August 23<sup>rd</sup> on a first-come-first-serve basis. The reservation code and info are below:
