# Government Marketing & Advertising

Government Communications and Public Engagement is responsible for the advertising policy and procedures for the Province of B.C., including the roles and responsibilities relating to communications services, materials and paid advertising.

Functional responsibilities vary depending on the type of information or materials required (i.e., informational or statutory). GCPE must be consulted regarding specific government requirements.

# Why does government advertise?

Government advertising is used to inform British Columbians about government priorities, programs, services or policies; or about dangers or risks to public health, safety or the environment; or an individual's rights or responsibilities.

Advertising may also be directed at audiences outside of the province and/or Canada to promote B.C.'s interests.

# Things to consider when planning a public information campaign.

In planning information campaigns, ministries must ensure products are aligned with government priorities, and support government's key themes and messages. Government advertising must be clearly identified as such, and follows established BCID guidelines.

# Know the criteria.

All advertising initiatives must meet the following criteria before project approval.

Advertisements must:

- Be fact-based
- Point to, or provide information on, government priorities, programs, services or policies
- Engage the public, providing an opportunity to interact or comment

Public funds must not be used to purchase advertising in support of a political party.

# Who needs to approve?

Ministries must obtain GCPE sign-off, through the Communications Director assigned to the ministry, for any materials prepared for public consumption, regardless of the medium used.

# Accessing GCPE's standing offers.

GCPE has an Agency of Record established to provide all government traditional advertising placement services, with the exception of employment recruitment advertising.

GCPE administers Standing Offers for advertising services that apply to all ministries. Services provided include, but are not limited to:

#### Good morning Kathryn

I spoke with ASC this morning and they have not been engaged by Health Canada to pre-clear Cannabis related advertising as they are for Alcoholic beverages. Health Canada and Industry engaged ASC to pre-clear advertising for Alcoholic beverages when it became too onerous for them and ASC anticipates that they might be requested to the same for Cannabis but there is no dialogue to date. ASC is not aware of any action that has been taken by Health Canada against any advertiser as of yet.

Our conclusion is that the request the Province received is likely internal due diligence being undertaken by the media suppliers to ensure they don't run afoul of the FDA and NCR regulations and have their licenses pulled.
