Price of New Housing -The cost of new housing in the province's three largest cities was lower in May than in the same month last year. The 1.4% decrease in Victoria was the result of a decline in housing prices (-2.3%), as land value (+0.7%) climbed. In B.C., the rate of opioid overdose deaths in the first five months of 2019 was 30% lower than the same period in 2018, and the monthly number of opioid overdose deaths in B.C. also appears to be falling - there were 82deaths in May this year, as opposed to 117 in May 2018. These numbers can change as more post-mortem results come in but experts are expressing "cautious optimism".
