Background:

- On August 8, the City of Victoria announced they will be taking down a statue of Sir John
 A. MacDonald at City Hall in light of the role he played in developing the residential
 school system.
- This was the first concrete action identified through a formal reconciliation process with the Songhees and Esquimalt Nations.
- They plan to find a way to "recontextualize" MacDonald and will keep the statue in storage until that is determined.
- Council voted 7-1 in favour of the plan. The statue is slated to come down on August 11.
