Re: tomorrow's phone availability with Chinese language media

### **Logistics:**

- We'll be using an open teleconference line, similar to what Minister has used in our farmers market nutrition coupon program announcements.
- You can both begin with short remarks, followed by a moderated Q&A session. Shannon will moderate.
- Media have been told that they'll have opportunity to ask a question, and time permitting, a follow-up as well. Would be good if we can give them each 2 questions.

## Themes/Potential Q's:

**SingTao** – Cambie legal decision, fall & winter preparedness plan, comment on Chinese-Canadian community's response to pandemic (geographic map over time has shown Richmond has lowest infection rate)

**MingPao** – We're seeing increasing numbers. Is this the 3<sup>rd</sup> wave? Are there measures/lessons from other countries that can be applied in BC?

OmniTV – School restart; As pandemic continues, and health care/COVID-19 response requires funding. How will government manage need for spending and challenge of economic recession?; for Dr. Henry – 139 cases today, what are considerations for going back to Phase 2?

**AM1320** – School restart; comparing BC's approach to other (read Asian) countries. Measures like controls at the airport: testing every traveler upon arrival, contact tracing on planes, tracking compliance with self-isolation using smartbands and fines. Why is BC's approach so laidback?

Bonnie, as usual you may expect questions about mandatory masks in schools and 1m physical distancing.
