#### SUMMARY:

Type:	Livestreamed event to announce BC Recovery Benefit, and BC Recovery Supplement for IA/DA clients		
Summary:	Following a key election promise, Minister Robinson will announce B.C.'s Economic Recovery Benefit which will provide 2.7 million families with up to \$1000, and individuals up to \$500 to help people struggling through the pandemic.  A new BC Recovery Supplement for Income and Disability Assistance clients will also be announced for application in January 2021.  Changes to Budget cycle/date may also be announced.

Message:	<ul> <li>This is an extraordinary time in our province as we work together to reduce the number of COVID cases in B.C.</li> <li>Many people are feeling extraordinary pressures and the holiday season is approaching — that's why we are coming forward with additional support for people in our province.</li> <li>The tax-free BC Recovery Benefit will help up to 2.7 million individuals and families:         <ul> <li>\$1,000 for families with incomes under \$125,000. Families earning up to \$175,000 will qualify for a reduced benefit amount.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>		

Events Planning 1

- \$500 for single people earning less than \$62,500. Single people earning up to \$87,500 will qualify for a reduced benefit amount.
- COVID-19 has disproportionately affected low- or no- income people who are feeling the pressure of keeping themselves and their families safe and supported.
- In addition to the BC Recovery Benefit, we are introducing a temporary BC Recovery Supplement for people on income and disability assistance and low-income seniors to March 2021. This is to carry them through the new year after the Crisis Supplement ends as scheduled in December.
- From January to March, they will receive an additional \$150 each month or \$450 total to help them through this stage of the pandemic. This means they will be eligible for up to \$950 over three months with the addition of the BC Recovery Benefit.
- These are in addition to the COVID-19 Action Plan and Economic Recovery Plan supports that we put in place for people and businesses throughout B.C.
