MEETING DETAILS: Meeting with Amenida Seniors' Community with Teena Love, General Manager at Amenida Seniors' Community and Steve Kim

BACKGROUND:

Amenida Seniors' Community has requested a meeting with the Minister on seniors housing. Amenida Seniors' Community is a senior's care facility in Surrey and offers independent living and assisted living. It is located in the Newton area of Surrey at 13855 68th Avenue.

They are looking at new opportunities in Coquitlam. They have the strategy and operational knowledge and would like some guidance on how to proceed.

RECOMMENDED RESPONSE:

Seniors housing in Surrey and Coquitlam:

- The Province is committed to building the strongest seniors support system in Canada by offering an array of diverse programs and services that allow seniors to live as independently as possible.
- In 2015/16, BC Housing invested more than \$47.8 million to provide subsidized housing and rent supplements for more than 8,000 households in Surrey. This includes providing support for approximately 3,500 senior households and more than 3,200 family households.
- In 2015/16, BC Housing invested more than \$9.3 million to provide subsidized housing and rent supplements for more than 2,200 households in Coquitlam. This includes providing support for approximately 930 senior households and more than 1,000 family households.
