Hi Nicholas

No doubt you have seen the article in today's Coast Reporter newspaper in which Wayne Rowe the mayor of Gibsons expresses his frustration with the lack of support from the current Minister of Health for the build of a new government funded Longterm Residential Care facility on the Sunshine Coast.

Over a year ago, Vancouver Coastal Health signed a contract with the well respected Trellis Group for the build of a new, state of the art, publicly funded Residential Care Facility to replace the existing Totem Lodge and Shorncliffe buildings and to provide us with twenty additional LTC beds.

The initial plan was to build the new facility in Sechelt. However, after months of dealing with a very unsupportive Sechelt Mayor, Town Council and planning department it became clear that our urgent new bed requirements could not be realized in Sechelt. The Trellis Group then looked at other locations to fulfil its contractual obligation.

The Mayor and Council of Gibsons have been most supportive in allowing Trellis to secure a suitable property on which to build and have guaranteed speedy approval of the necessary permits to build. All that remains is for VCH to approve the new location. It has failed to do so.

As you know, I brought up the issue of insufficient long-term care beds long before the government changed, so I hope you are equally "disgusted" by the previous administration for their delays and for their self-sabotaging planning process. I didn't create this outrage. This is a fine mess we inherited.

Rest assured the Minister is well aware of the urgent need for increased long-term care on the Sunshine Coast. He also knows about the ten thousand signature petition, the uncertainty around predicted job losses, the restrictions of the land use designation, the concern of the Sechelt elders, and the implication of the change of location on residents living north of Sechelt. I will work hard to try to get a good solution for everyone.

I hope that in the future, good planning will prevent this kind of mess from occurring in the first place.







In response to inquiries from my office, Vancouver Coastal Health informs me that the BC Renal Agency (BCPRA) funds kidney care services, while direct patient care is managed by the Health Authorities. According to VCH, these "Community Dialysis Units" (CDU) are meant to provide an option for dialysis services closer to a patient's home, but only to ambulatory, medically stable, relatively independent outpatients –and are not equipped for any other level of care. Despite the fact that Powell River's CDU is located in the hospital, VCH states that it is a "distinct outpatient area, not operated as part of the hospital's normal inpatient operations."

Vancouver Coastal Health further explains that the reason for this is patient safety, and makes a case that should a patient require admission, their condition makes it inherently unsafe to be dialysed in a CDU, but rather in a hospital-based unit. Even though Powell River General Hospital is a hospital-based unit, it is not one that treats inpatients.

I understand the rationale of the policies outlined above, but hope that a better solution can be found for the unique but rare circumstances facing Powell River area residents who receive dialysis through the CDU but who may be admitted to hospital.



I am writing to you today to ask that you please consider funding Medical Abortions in British Columbia, specifically that you authorize British Columbia join other provinces across Canada and offer Mifepristone or "Mifegymiso (Canada)" to women as an alternative to surgical abortions.

Currently, Alberta, Ontario, Quebec and New Brunswick all offer women the choice to have a fully funded surgical abortion or grant access to fully funded medical abortions. In BC, there is not universal coverage for Mifegymiso. It is covered for those on social assistance and to First Nations women and some third-party insurers have also included Mifegymiso but other women must be admitted to a hospital to use Mifegymiso.

As I am sure you will appreciate, the view of the medical community is that this is not working as physicians do not see patients in the hospital and so they are not able to offer a prescription.

As a result, women in BC are not being treated equally and economics is a contributing and potentially limiting factor for women who may wish to use Mifegymiso to terminate a pregnancy. Mifepristone is considered the "gold standard" for medical abortion. It is extremely effective. It can be used up to 70 days gestation and in the provinces where there is universal coverage there is a decrease of surgical intervention by 30%. As Mifegymiso becomes more available and covered we will continue to see a significant decrease in surgical demand. This will result in an overall saving to the health care system and release valuable surgical time.

Women will no longer have to leave their communities for abortion services and can abort in the privacy of their own home with a partner or friend. The medical community reports that many women feel a medical abortion is less invasive and more natural. Some women say they feel more in control during the process.

Minister, I would encourage you to review the coverage for Mifepristone / Mifegymiso in British Columbia and recommend granting universal access to this new option.

In 1995, the Government of British Columbia introduced the *Access to Abortion Services Act* (1995) to prohibit protests outside abortion clinics, and doctors' offices and homes. The first of its kind in Canada, the Act places specific, geographical limits on free speech to protect vulnerable people, specifically those seeking and performing legal abortion services.

Despite this Act, the Vancouver Island Women's Clinic in View Royal has repeatedly had challenges with anti-choice protestors confronting staff, doctors and vulnerable patients on their way to and from the medical centre. Housed in a multi-story plaza, the layout of the building means that protestors are an inescapable presence at the clinic.

As you may remember, previous Esquimalt-Royal Roads MLA Maurine Karagianis first brought this issue forward to then Minister of Health Terry Lake and Mr. Lake was unwilling at that time to grant an extension to the bubble zone to protect the clinic. I know that you have spoken in favour of this very issue in the Legislature and that you supported Ms. Karagianis' motion to extend the bubble zone back in 2015. The argument that this supports the rights of these women and a reasonable zone should be applied remains pertinent to this situation.

This request is to extend the bubble zone to the maximum, so that it will be appropriate to the location of the facility. Minister, I am asking you to please implement the necessary extension to the bubble zone around the Vancouver Island Women's Clinic in View Royal as soon as possible to ensure that women have unencumbered access to abortion services on the South Island.




