Good evening Minister – here is the information you requested earlier today regarding background on Casa Mia:

- VCH was not involved in the previous submissions which was for exclusively private pay beds;
 VCH only recently became a partner through their Residential Care rejuvenation strategy
- On June 1, 2016 VCH issued a news release stating that part of their 10 year rejuvenation strategy they had signed agreements for a new residential care facility in Vancouver (Casa Mia 58 publically funded and 29 private pay)) and an expansion to Point Grey Private Hospital (58 publically funded beds and 26 private). At the time they noted completion to Casa Mia, subject to zoning, was late 2019.
- VCH's understanding about challenges associated with the initial submission is that there was
 some opposition from a community group regarding building a new private pay facility in a
 historic residential neighbourhood, as well as concerns regarding lack of sidewalks, parking and
 transit. Traffic and pedestrian safety has been raised this time and staff were not aware of plans
 to address; however VCH believes the provider has agreed to provide a shuttle for staff to get
 to/from work.
- A VCH representative met with the City of Vancouver and members of the public on May 24, 2017 who were pleased to hear about the change to a) publicly subsidized beds, and b) building design. The public shared favorable impressions of the current plans for Casa Mia at the City of Vancouver Open House on June 6, 2017. The proposal provides a presence in the southwest Vancouver area, that has not previously existed
