Ability to get a non-photo BC Services Card extended

VICTORIA – British Columbians enrolled in the Medical Services Plan (MSP) who have adopted a hyphenated surname, or a name other than their legal name can continue to obtain a non-photo BC Services Card along with their photo driver's licence or BCID.

This exemption was slated to run out on March 1, 2018 at which point citizens would have been required to get a photo BC Services card with their legal name.

Over the next several months, the Ministries of Health and Citizen's Services will be working with ICBC to identify solutions that will allow for the majority of affected individuals to obtain a photo BC Services Card using their preferred name without undergoing a legal name change.

In February 2013, the plan to roll out the BC Services Card was announced – requiring all British Columbians to re-enrol in MSP over the next five years, tying it to the renewal of their driver's licence. Then, in 2016 ICBC changed their policy regarding the use of adopted hyphenated names or names other than a legal name on driver's licences to align with government practices which requires that government identification reflect a person's legal name.

It is important to note that no one eligible for provincially insured medical services will have them denied. Currently, over 4.3 million residents have been issued a BC Services Card – this represents approximately 90% of existing MSP beneficiaries.

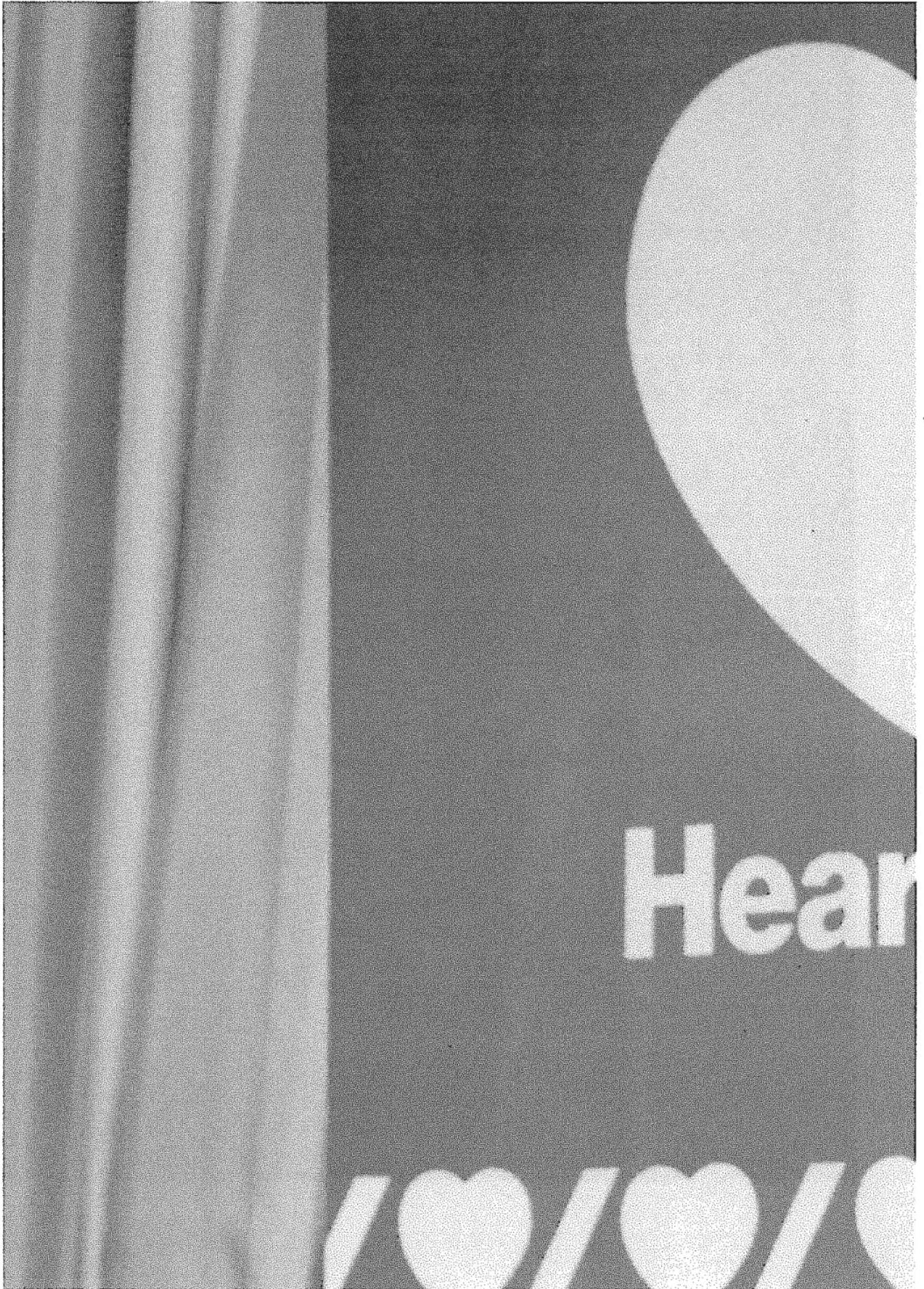

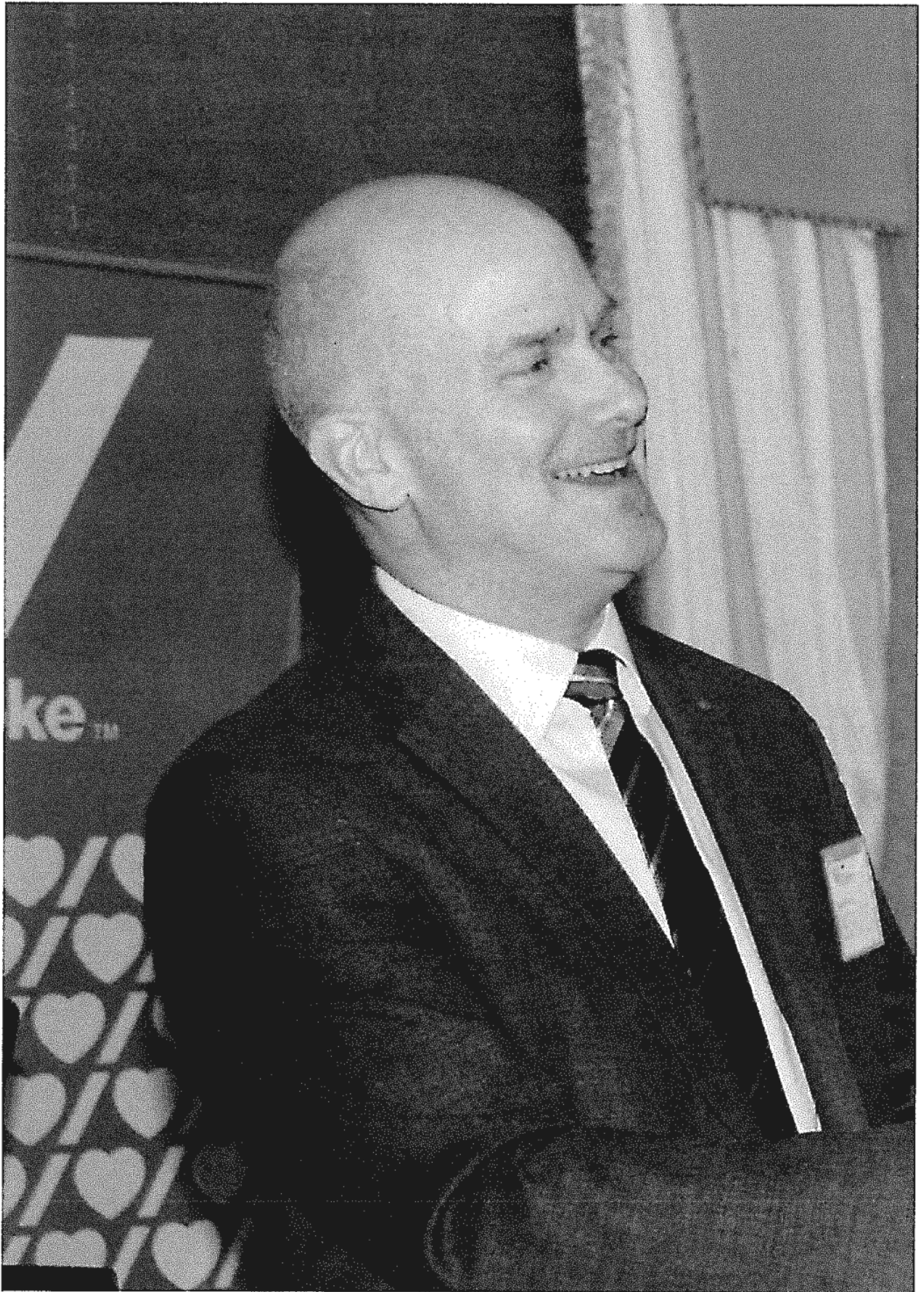
