New Social Media Guidelines

Social media plays an expanding role in the everyday lives and work of public service employees. Our social media activity, whether as an individual or in an official capacity, can impact public trust and confidence. Our use of social media in official capacities also impacts the quality and responsiveness of service we provide for citizens.

As employees, we are responsible to ensure our social media activities comply with the Oath of Employment, <u>Standards of Conduct</u> and other policies and regulations we follow as public service employees.

To help understand these obligations and support you in making informed choices, new personal-use and updated government-use guidelines have been developed.

Personal use

The BC Public Service Agency is launching the new <u>Social Media Guidelines for BC Public Service Employees</u> to inform your personal use of social media as a public servant. While the guidelines for personal use are new, the expectations they reflect are not. They focus on the principles that will help you make informed choices about your online activity that won't conflict with your commitments to the BC Public Service. They don't prevent you from using social media – they are just intended to help you ensure you're using social media consistent with the Standards of Conduct and other corporate policies.

If you have questions about appropriate professional or personal use of social media, <u>review the resources available on MyHR</u>, and then talk to your supervisor or your ministry ethics advisor.

Government use

Government Communications and Public Engagement has updated the <u>Guidelines for Government Use of Social Media by B.C. Public Servants</u>. The revised guidelines focus on official government use of social media like setting up and managing social media accounts and engaging in citizen consultations. In addition, the guidelines establish clear processes and best social media practices for supporting key priorities across government.

Support for seniors gymnastics scores a perfect 10

DELTA - An innovative program that keeps seniors active and healthy by getting them on the gymnastics floor is receiving provincial support.

Thanks to a \$150,000 grant, the Delta Gymanstics Society's Seniors Can Move program will be continuing and expanding classes locally, and starting up in other communities over the coming months. "Our government is proud to support the Seniors Can Move program, the first of its kind in B.C. which gets seniors on the gynmnastics floor to improve their strength and agility," said Adrian Dix, Minister of Health. "This creative program is already making a big difference in the health of local seniors through improving balance, building confidence in movement and helping with falls prevention."

"The Delta Gymnastics Society has designed a fantastic program that is using physical literacy to help participants both regain their mobility, and build friendships across all age spans. This program clearly has tremendous potential to get seniors across the province moving, promoting their physical health and social connections," said Ravi Kahlon, Parliamentary Secretary for Sport and Multiculturalism.

The Seniors Can Move program was developed by the Delta Gymnastics Society in 2018, and enables seniors to take part in physical activity in a gymnastics setting. Thanks to the \$150,000 grant, which is being provided through Fraser Health, the Society will continue to offer the hour-long group class and expand it to five times a week for the summer, and eight times of week in the fall. The first day of summer class starts today, July 2, running to August 29th.

Classes are open to all Delta seniors, and registration is free. Program capacity have grown up to 150 participants. The classes includes simple stretching routines, as well as other exercises designed to help improve agility, balance, coordination and strength.

The Delta Gymnastics Society will also create a course based on the program that can be taught and replicated at any gymnastics facility. The society will scale the 10-week program to pilot it at 16 other facilities in British Columbia with a goal of providing 75 weeks of program delivery through fall 2020. As well they will bring geriatric professionals like nurses and physiotherapists in to Delta Gymnastics for specialized consultations to support seniors' health.

The Delta Gymnastics Society has been offering a wide range of high-quality recreational and competitive programs since 1975. The society has more than 2,000 members and continues to grow. Members range in age from 6 months to over 80 years old.

Nearly one-fifth of B.C.'s population is over 65, and the number of seniors is expected to rise from 916,400 in 2018 to 1.4 million by 2032.

It was nice speaking with you on the phone moments ago and thank you for your assistance. As mentioned, I would like to schedule an appointment with Anne Kang to speak with her about the Burnaby Better at Home program. Citizen Support Services is the lead agency for the Better at Home program in Burnaby and we are partnered with Burnaby Community Services and MOSAIC to deliver

these services. We understand that 42 sites in British Columbia have received additional funding and Burnaby is not one of those. We have over a hundred people on the waitlist with no end in sight. Good morning Anne Kang,

It's Jason Tutt here with the BC Association of TCM & Acupuncture Practitioners (ATCMA). I am not sure if you have been reading the recent articles about Health Canada's crackdown on stem cell therapies. Here are a few to bring you up to speed if you have not (they are short reads).

I spoke with Health Canada on the phone this morning about whether the therapy we offer called Platelet Rich Plasma (PRP) which involves the collection of whole blood, then fractionated to isolate it's healing component and then re-injected back into an injured area would falls under their definitions of cell therapies. The representative from Heath Canada assured me that they consider stem cells and PRP for orthopedic applications as two separate therapies however Health Canada is treating them similar in a few ways.

PRP is considered a drug under the <u>Food and Drug Act</u> that has not yet been authorized on a federal level for the treatment of any indications. If a health professional was preparing PRP it would be considered manufacturing of an unauthorized drug and fall under federal jurisdiction. However, she also explained that the difference between PRP and stem cells is

that if PRP is prepared at the bed side for immediate use for orthopedic applications then it **could** be considered **compounding of a drug** rather than manufacturing of a drug if it meets certain requirements.

Compounding of a drug would fall to provincial jurisdiction rather than federal jurisdiction only if the respective profession has both "compounding of a drug" and "prescribing of a drug" written into their provincial scope of practice. Since the TCM profession is still waiting for the Ministry of Health BC to move forward with our new scope of practice, it looks like we will be ordered to stop offering this therapy by our regulatory College until we get our new scope of practice. The problem is, we still have not heard from the Ministry any update on when this could take place. Just that they remained committed to working on this in the near future.

I have attached a file which contained 7 letters specifically related to how PRP has impacted our patient's lives. If needed I am sure we could get more but I will wait for your direction. This crackdown by Health Canada has put the TCM profession is a tough spot and could be easily remedied if the Ministry of Health would act on our scope of practice which is long overdue!

Please let me know what next steps you recommend.

Good morning Anne Kang,

It's Jason Tutt here with the BC Association of TCM & Acupuncture Practitioners (ATCMA). I am not sure if you have been reading the recent articles about Health Canada's crackdown on stem cell therapies. Here are a few to bring you up to speed if you have not (they are short reads).

I spoke with Health Canada on the phone this morning about whether the therapy we offer

called Platelet Rich Plasma (PRP) which involves the collection of whole blood, then fractionated to isolate it's healing component and then re-injected back into an injured area would falls under their definitions of cell therapies. The representative from Heath Canada assured me that they consider stem cells and PRP for orthopedic applications as two separate therapies however Health Canada is treating them similar in a few ways.

PRP is considered a drug under the <u>Food and Drug Act</u> that has not yet been authorized on a federal level for the treatment of any indications. If a health professional was preparing PRP it would be considered manufacturing of an unauthorized drug and fall under federal jurisdiction. However, she also explained that the difference between PRP and stem cells is that if PRP is prepared at the bed side for immediate use for orthopedic applications then it **could** be considered **compounding of a drug** rather than manufacturing of a drug if it meets certain requirements.

Compounding of a drug would fall to provincial jurisdiction rather than federal jurisdiction only if the respective profession has both "compounding of a drug" and "prescribing of a drug" written into their provincial scope of practice. Since the TCM profession is still waiting for the Ministry of Health BC to move forward with our new scope of practice, it looks like we will be ordered to stop offering this therapy by our regulatory College until we get our new scope of practice. The problem is, we still have not heard from the Ministry any update on when this could take place. Just that they remained committed to working on this in the near future. I have attached a file which contained 7 letters specifically related to how PRP has impacted our patient's lives. If needed I am sure we could get more but I will wait for your direction. This crackdown by Health Canada has put the TCM profession is a tough spot and could be easily remedied if the Ministry of Health would act on our scope of practice which is long overdue! Please let me know what next steps you recommend.

I'm attaching a submission from Burnaby Public Library to the Select Standing Committee on Finance and Government Services.

In our submission, we urge the Select Standing Committee on Finance and Government Services to act on our shared understanding that provincial government financial support is critical to the successful continuance of public libraries and their positive impact on BC communities.

While libraries appreciate the stability of grant funding that government has provided since 2010 (approximately \$14 million per year), the lack of regular increases means that each year libraries receive less and less support, due to inflationary pressures. After many years of this, libraries are falling behind in their ability to meet growing needs. Since 2009 the public library community has asked that the provincial government provide funding for public libraries that at a minimum includes annual increases to account for inflation. Despite these repeated requests, for the past decade public libraries have received no increase to funding. This year we are asking the provincial government for \$20 million for public libraries in 2020 as this will help address the chronic under-funding, lack of increases for inflation, and past government cuts.

Library Board Chair Lorraine Shore and I would be happy to meet with you to discuss this issue further if you have any questions.




