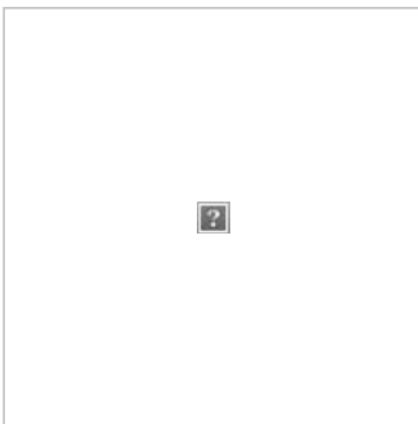

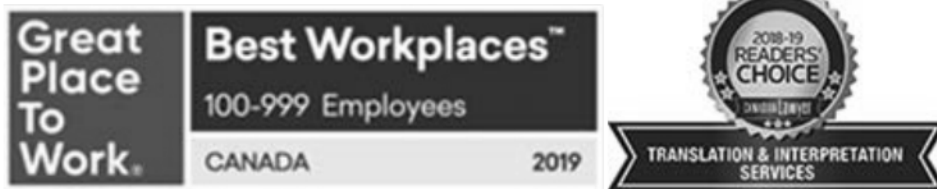

Dear Honorable Bruce Ralston:

We, the Taiwanese-Canadian Association, humbly request the Government of British Columbia to re-open the BC-Taiwanese Trade Office in Taipei, Taiwan. We are a non-political organization consisting of Canadian citizens of mostly Taiwanese ancestry who are also residents of BC. We write to you as our MLA and, especially, as the Minister of Jobs, Tourism and Technology Trade Minister of British Columbia.

We are delighted to notice that the possibility of establishing a B.C. trade office in Taiwan has in fact been discussed at the B. C. legislative Assembly. In 2018, Honorable Andrew Weaver, leader of the B. C. 3rd political party, initiated the discussion. You responded with your recognition of the importance of trade between B.C. and Taiwan and the increasing trade with Taiwan is taking place in Canada. You promised to pursue the topic further. We have also informally heard that a B. C. trade office in Taiwan had in fact existed before. The foundation for establishing a B.C. trade office in Taiwan thus has been laid.

We wish to emphasize the suitability and importance for an expanded trade by B.C. with Taiwan and, therefore, the re-opening of a B.C. trade office there. As it is well known that Taiwan is a democratic state with an elected political system as that in Canada. In business and commerce, Taiwan has much technical expertise to contribute to the B.C. and Canadian economy. At the same time, Taiwan is a strong consumer of B.C. goods and services and hence an important importer of Canadian goods and services. Taiwan is a market share leader in many critical technologies such as integrated circuit design and manufacturing. According to the WEF 2018 Global Competitiveness Rankings, Taiwan ranked 4th globally on “Innovation Capability”. Such capacity is recognized and is beginning to be utilized by Canada. The Government of Canada (Date Modified: 2019-06-26) reported that the Canadian Trade Office in Taipei (CTOT) recently launched the Canadian Technology Accelerator (CTA) in Taiwan. Funded by Global Affairs Canada, the initiative “aims to make both Canada and Taiwan’s start-up and innovation ecosystems more successful” (CTA). It supports high-potential Canadian technology companies’ fast-track their market entry and scale their business in Taiwan and Asia.

At the same time, Taiwan provides a sizable market for Canadian goods. According to a reader’s letter for The Star (March 14, 2018), while small in size, Taiwan imports billions of agricultural products every year from Canada.

Indeed, Canada and B.C. and Taiwan have had a trade history and the trade has been expanding. According to a government report (Economics, Resources and International

Affairs Division, 06-18, 2014, Publication No. 2014-56-E), in 2013, Canada–Taiwan merchandise trade totaled \$6.2 billion, comprised of \$1.5 billion in Canadian exports to, and \$4.7 billion in imports from, Taiwan. Taiwan comprised Canada’s 20th largest export destination worldwide in 2013. In that year, it was Canada’s 10th largest source of imports globally. At the provincial/territorial level, British Columbia and Ontario together accounted for 61.5% of the value of Canada’s exports to Taiwan in 2013, with exports valued at \$606.1 million and \$321.5 million respectively. Taiwan is Canada’s fifth-largest trade partner in Asia, with bilateral trade exceeding \$7 billion (Canadian) in 2017, as reported in *The Star* (March 14, 2018, Readers’ Letters). At the above Legislative Assembly in 2018, Honorable Weaver reported that “Taiwan is B.C.’s sixth-largest trading partner, with bilateral trade volume totaling an estimated \$1.87 billion.” You added that “fully 43 percent of Canadian exports to Taiwan originate in British Columbia”). Canada thus has a significant trading relationship with Taiwan and B.C. have been a major Canadian trade partner with Taiwan. B.C. could become the leader of Canadian trade with Taiwan.

Taiwan would especially serve as a convenient conduit for Canada to operate within the Comprehensive and Progressive Agreement for Trans-Pacific Partnership (CPTPP) which Canada recently joined. This is not only because of Taiwan’s proximity to B.C. and is one of the Asian states but also because of its active trading with the CPTPP members. According to a reader’s letter to the *Star* (March 14, 2018), CPTPP’s current members account for 25 percent of Taiwan’s foreign trade and 30.42 percent of its accumulated foreign investment. Taiwan’s trade with CPTPP countries amounted to \$129 billion (U.S.) in 2016. In the Asia-Pacific region, Taiwan also plays a critical role in the supply chains of electronics, machinery, textiles, auto parts, and other goods.

By itself, Taiwan has a very strong economy. According to the 2018 *Doing Business* (published on the web link), Taiwan ranks 13th out of 190 world economies and is the 18th-biggest trading power and the 25th-largest economy in the world. At the same time, Taiwan ranks 4th in Asia Pacific for ease of doing business. A B.C. trade office in Taiwan would serve as a good facilitator for the trade between B.C., Canada and Taiwan and convenient entry for Canada into the Pacific region.

In the Legislative Assembly referred to earlier, you especially mentioned that the federal government has a trade office in Taipei. A trade office by B.C. in Taiwan would complement the federal trade office in Taiwan. A trade office established by B.C., therefore, would not only expand B.C. trade and service but also facilitate trades for other Canadian provinces, rendering valuable service to Canada as a whole. Such an office would further help Canadian businesses expand into the Pacific region.

Broadening international trades for Canada is especially important now with the trade an impasse with China who has been a significant trading partner of Canada. However, using economic coercion, China has manipulated trading partners including Canada to its favor. Because of politics, certain economic sanction is being applied to Canada by China, jeopardizing the livelihood of Canadian business and producers. It is now ever more important for Canada to expand its trade to other countries such as those in the Asian-Pacific region other than China. With geographical proximity and an already trading relationship with Canada and B.C., Taiwan can provide a stepstone for B.C. to operate its trade into and within the Pacific region. A B.C. trade office in Taiwan would only benefit B.C. and Canada directly and ultimately.

We, therefore, respectfully ask you and the B.C. Legislation Assembly to re-open the B.C. trade office in Taiwan. The office would be complementary to the Canadian CTA and would serve as a connector for other provinces which are further away from the Pacific region. Citizens of B.C. and other provinces would greatly benefit from a strong B.C. trade tie with Taiwan and the presence of a B.C. trade office in Taiwan would strengthen the tie.

More opportunities for seniors in Kamloops to maintain social connections

KAMLOOPS – The Province has provided \$100,000 in funding to the Centre for Seniors Information BC Interior Society to further improve access to community-based seniors' services in Kamloops and to help them stay engaged, remain independent and age in place.

"Seniors are the hearts of our communities and it is crucial that they remain independent and socially engaged for as long as possible to help prevent social isolation, which can affect their physical and mental wellbeing," said Adrian Dix, Minister of Health. "That's why we are supporting community organizations, including the Centre for Seniors Information BC Interior Society, that are helping to improve the social, physical and nutritional needs of seniors in B.C. This is another step that we are taking to help seniors live more independent and full lives." **[NOT**

APPROVED]

The funding will give the Centre for Seniors Information BC Interior Society in Kamloops the resources they need to continue providing programs and services such as advocacy, education, support, socialization and outreach services to around 13,000 senior residents in Kamloops and the surrounding area. These programs and services are aimed at ensuring that seniors keep their independence for as long as possible.

"Lack of social connectedness can affect the overall wellbeing of seniors. That's why I am proud of our government's support to the organizations that are contributing to improving the lives of seniors in their communities," said Anne Kang, Parliamentary Secretary for seniors and multiculturalism. "By increasing access to the community-based seniors' services and programs they need, we can support seniors to live independent lives and stay physically and socially active." **[NOT APPROVED]**

This follows the ministry's recent announcement about improving access to transportation services for seniors in the province, which also helps to address social isolation. In Interior Health, six community organizations received approximately \$500,000 to further their transportation services in the community. This includes the Kamloops Aboriginal Friendship Society that received \$2,000 to purchase heavy duty aluminium steps to assist seniors with van access. Together, these supports illustrate the Province's commitment to seniors living in every corner of B.C.

"We thank the B.C. government for its commitment to support community organizations that are working hard to help seniors be more socially engaged," said Brenda Prevost,

operations manager at the Centre for Seniors Information BC Interior Society. “With this funding, we will be able to continue providing the quality programs and services that senior residents in Kamloops rely on.”

The Centre for Seniors Information BC Interior Society has been supporting seniors in Kamloops since 1997. The society is working to ensure seniors remain active and connected to the community through services that ensure quality of life, dignity and choice.

Supporting community-based seniors’ services is part of government’s commitment to strengthen the supports available to seniors. Government is investing \$1.018 billion over three years to improve care for seniors, including investments in primary care, home health, long-term care and assisted living. This also includes \$75 million over three years to expand respite and adult day services and \$240 million over three years to increase staffing levels in long-term care homes, with the goal of achieving 3.36 direct care hours per resident day – on average – across all health authorities by the end of 2020-21.

Quick Facts:

- In 2019, 19% of B.C.’s population is over 65, and in 15 years this percentage is expected to rise to 25%.
- Community-based seniors’ services play an important role in supporting seniors to age in their own homes by improving access to physical and social activities and healthy food, helping them live healthier lives.
