#### Hi Kathy,

Yes, we have had many, many discussions about this issue particularly with colleagues in other provinces in Canada where take home naloxone is a newer concept. The bottom line for us is we purposely link the rescue breaths to a 'witnessed overdose' or an event where people know that is what is happening (for example friends or family who know a person has used drugs). Our 911 folk are good at this messaging as well. If it is just someone coming across someone who collapsed on the street then CPR is initiated. This has worked very well here and we have had thousands of uses of naloxone and rescue breaths by lay people to rescue someone without incident including thousands at our overdose prevention and supervised consumptions sites with no deaths.

The other important consideration is that it is really oxygen people need if they have overdosed and we do not really want someone doing chest compressions and potentially breaking ribs and leading to more pain and suffering for someone who has addictions to opioids. People have become really good at the 'save me' protocol and it is being taught by community agencies like St John's Ambulance along with CPR.
