PPE Update – Monday November 16, 2020

- To recap BC's cumulative totals, from March to last week's report on Monday November 9, the following PPE has arrived in BC:
 - Just over 7,400,000 N95 or equivalent respirators

- **Just over 126,000,000 surgical or procedure masks**
- **Almost 2,900,000 pieces of eye protection, including goggles and face shields**
- **Almost 222,500,000 pairs of gloves**
- **Just over 13,300,000 gowns**
- Many of the items listed above, and other supplies and equipment that have recently arrived, are in our testing process to make sure product meets or exceeds safety requirements before being used in BC's healthcare system.
- Over the last week (since the update last week on Monday November 9 up until yesterday), the following PPE has arrived in BC:
 - **49,166 N95 or equivalent respirators**
 - **352,250 surgical or procedure masks**
 - **1,325 pieces of eye protection**
 - **1,164,800 pairs of gloves**
 - **703,974 gowns**
- These numbers do not yet include supplies that arrived in YVR late last week on a massive Antonov cargo plane, which contains 650 cubic metres (or 430 pallets) of PPE for the health care system. The Provincial Health Services Authority supply chain team is working to move that significant volume of PPE to the main warehouse for sorting, counting, and validation. I'll be able to report on these volumes, plus other PPE receive we expect to receive this week, at next week's briefing.
- BC continues to source and test PPE and are working hard to pursue any and all credible leads for safe and effective product for our health system.

Hi Peter, Carolyn,

This arrived yesterday so will be counted with this weeks arrivals and reported next Monday.

The Antonov 124 cargo plan has delivered 650 CBM (Cubic Metres) to us. 650 CBM equates to 430 Pallets. To put it in perspective a fully loaded 767 cargo plane maxes out at 330 CBM which equates to 220 pallets. So twice as many pallets in an Antonov than a 767.

Hi Peter, Carolyn,

This arrived yesterday so will be counted with this weeks arrivals and reported next Monday.

The Antonov 124 cargo plan has delivered 650 CBM (Cubic Metres) to us. 650 CBM equates to 430 Pallets. To put it in perspective a fully loaded 767 cargo plane maxes out at 330 CBM which equates to 220 pallets. So twice as many pallets in an Antonov than a 767.
