**Request Details:**

Any reports, briefing notes or other forms of information of aggregated data since September 1, 2020, not including personal information of any deceased, showing the number and/or percent of health conditions among COVID-19 deaths, including but not limited to from any of the following: hypertension, dementia, cardio-vascular diseases, renal diseases, diabetes, respiratory diseases, cancer, stroke, liver diseases, immune-deficiency diseases and so on including any individuals. For the purposes of clarity and specificity this includes reports of conditions that are generally described as co-morbidities.

**Responsive Records:**

As of December 8, 2020, 87% of people who deceased from COVID-19 had at least one of the following health conditions that were observed in Ministry health administrative data over a two-year period: cancer, chronic kidney disease, chronic neurological conditions, diabetes mellitus, heart conditions, hypertension, immunocompromised, liver disease, obesity, pregnancy, problems with spleen, respiratory diseases, rheumatoid & other inflammatory arthropathy, severe chest conditions, or transplant recipient/complication.
