Much of Hyder is vaccinated, but the Governor is going there for other reasons and wanted to bring extra vaccine to make sure anyone who wants it gets a second chance. We are not allowed to transfer it between countries, but as you know, we live and work closely together so we are going to offer it at airports and want to make sure all border communities are fully protected as we are all in this together!
