Manitoba gets the first 200,000 doses, then everything else is distributed on a pro-rata basis to those who purchase in 2021. That 200,000 dose volume is about one day's production. I am sure you understand that nuance.s.16

This is a two-shot vaccine program, the same as Moderna and Pfizer/BioNTech. The cold chain required at this stage is like the Moderna requirements, but we are doing work to see if we can work with an easier cold chain requirement even than that.

The person who leads the KPMG due diligence team in Toronto is John Cho. We expect they will complete their report to Ontario today.
