Trish

- Abbotsford West MLA Miachel de Jong said for over 15 years the BC Nutrition Program in schools has provided over half a million students in over 1400 schools fresh fruit, vegetables and milk. It's bene a tremendous success until now. The small society that runs this program has been told their government funding is ending and won't be continued. To agriculture minister, why is government eliminating funding for a program that has provided half a million students with fresh BC food? Minister of Agriculture Lana Popham responded the fruit and vegetable program has been very valuable and we've worked with association for a number of years. The funding comes from Ministry of Health and we've had discussions on ways to support this incredible association. Supplemental quote from school staff that the vegetables some of these children receive are the only vegetables they have access to. Many letters of support for this program that only costs roughly \$3-4M, same increase the Premier's office is seeing. This organization will have to notify 1000 farmers that their goods are no longer required. The merits speak for themselves. Will Minister confirm the funding that kept this program alive will continue? Minister Popham stated we are looking at ways on how to support this program and will discuss with Ministry of Health. It is correct that this is the only way some children receive fresh foods and we will be looking at ways to support such programs.
- Delta South MLA Ian Paton very involved in this fresh food program, and know the importance of this in young people's lives. This program has been seeking funding since February, met with Ministry of Agriculture in March, and emailed in April asking if program will be gov funded with a response due back by May 10th. Deadline passed with no funding for the program, yet \$4M for more support in Premier's office. Why did they find money for the Premier's Office but not for children in BC? Minister Popham responded this is a very valuable program that many schools depend on. We will be working with Health and Education to look at how the program can continue. We know the earlier children get a taste of fresh produce the more chance they have to be healthy eaters. We will be working together to distribute produce around BC.

- Abbotsford West MLA Miachel de Jong said for over 15 years the BC Nutrition Program in schools has provided over half a million students in over 1400 schools fresh fruit, vegetables and milk. It's bene a tremendous success until now. The small society that runs this program has been told their government funding is ending and won't be continued. To agriculture minister, why is government eliminating funding for a program that has provided half a million students with fresh BC food? Minister of Agriculture Lana Popham responded the fruit and vegetable program has been very valuable and we've worked with association for a number of years. The funding comes from Ministry of Health and we've had discussions on ways to support this incredible association. Supplemental quote from school staff that the vegetables some of these children receive are the only vegetables they have access to. Many letters of support for this program that only costs roughly \$3-4M, same increase the Premier's office is seeing. This organization will have to notify 1000 farmers that their goods are no longer required. The merits speak for themselves. Will Minister confirm the funding that kept this program alive will continue? Minister Popham stated we are looking at ways on how to support this program and will discuss with Ministry of Health. It is correct that this is the only way some children receive fresh foods and we will be looking at ways to support such programs.
- Delta South MLA Ian Paton very involved in this fresh food program, and know the importance of this in young people's lives. This program has been seeking funding since February, met with Ministry of Agriculture in March, and emailed in April asking if program will be gov funded with a response due back by May 10th. Deadline passed with no funding for the program, yet \$4M for more support in Premier's office. Why did they find money for the Premier's Office but not for children in BC? Minister Popham responded this is a very valuable program that many schools depend on. We will be working with Health and Education to look at how the program can continue. We know the earlier children get a taste of fresh produce the more chance they have to be healthy eaters. We will be working together to distribute produce around BC.

- 1. Pacific Postpartum Society (previously funded 2019 & 2020)

Abbotsford West MLA Miachel de Jong said for over 15 years the BC Nutrition Program in schools has
provided over half a million students in over 1400 schools fresh fruit, vegetables and milk. It's bene a
tremendous success until now. The small society that runs this program has been told their government
funding is ending and won't be continued. To agriculture minister, why is government eliminating funding
for a program that has provided half a million students with fresh BC food? Minister of Agriculture Lana

Popham responded the fruit and vegetable program has been very valuable and we've worked with association for a number of years. The funding comes from Ministry of Health and we've had discussions on ways to support this incredible association. Supplemental – quote from school staff that the vegetables some of these children receive are the only vegetables they have access to. Many letters of support for this program that only costs roughly \$3-4M, same increase the Premier's office is seeing. This organization will have to notify 1000 farmers that their goods are no longer required. The merits speak for themselves. Will Minister confirm the funding that kept this program alive will continue? Minister Popham stated we are looking at ways on how to support this program and will discuss with Ministry of Health. It is correct that this is the only way some children receive fresh foods and we will be looking at ways to support such programs.

• Delta South MLA Ian Paton very involved in this fresh food program, and know the importance of this in young people's lives. This program has been seeking funding since February, met with Ministry of Agriculture in March, and emailed in April asking if program will be gov funded with a response due back by May 10th. Deadline passed with no funding for the program, yet \$4M for more support in Premier's office. Why did they find money for the Premier's Office but not for children in BC? Minister Popham responded this is a very valuable program that many schools depend on. We will be working with Health and Education to look at how the program can continue. We know the earlier children get a taste of fresh produce the more chance they have to be healthy eaters. We will be working together to distribute produce around BC.




