Dear Dr. Henry:

I am the one who first contacted Point Roberts's Fire Chief, Christopher Carleton, on April 14th, to urge him to contact his local Congressman, Senators, and Washington's governor with the goal of setting up a large vaccination center right across the border to vaccinate US citizens and Canadians living in Canada. We discussed this via emails (see below) and phone conversations where I presented suggestions on how this might be done. He did this several weeks later. Perhaps I could also be of further assistance to you in facilitating this process?

When President Biden informed Prime Minister Trudeau that the US would not be shipping vaccines to Canada in early March, I realized that President Biden had a problem. He could not ship vaccines to one country without other countries complaining that they should get them instead. Also, the perception would be bad for him if he was seen as shipping vaccines out of the country if some US citizens could still not get them.

Hence I wrote a letter to the White House (and others, see copy of fax at end of this email) on March 4th saying that there were about 1 million US citizens living in Canada (Many of whom are eligible to vote in US presidential elections), and the US needed to help vaccinate them (and also Canadians due to the strong ties between our countries). I was pleased when I saw several weeks later that the US promised 1.5 million doses of vaccine to Canada.

I then realized that if we could not bring vaccines to Canada fast enough, then we should try to bring Canadians to the vaccines in the US. The US is already vaccinating Canadian citizens in Florida, Arizona, and other states with no problems. Same with vaccinations done in Point Roberts, which being in the US, avoids the US actually shipping vaccines to Canada (and all the political issues that raises).

Hence I contacted the Point Roberts Fire Chief to suggest that we work on getting approval to set up a vast vaccination clinic right at the border where Canadians could just drive in, get a 15 minute Covid test, and if negative, get vaccinated (and then just turn around and go back across the border, or if allowed, could also visit Point Roberts restaurants and shops – hence the Point Roberts community would also benefit from this too) - see emails below. 2 weeks later he sent out his letter (attached) to local politicians and Cc it to the press making this proposal official.

Been unable to get vaccine in Canada yet. Do you know what the rules are for her driving back into Canada from Point Roberts?

BTW, I read that Point Roberts had very few cases of Covid, is landlocked, and that the businesses in Point Roberts are suffering because the border is closed.

I have a suggestion that would help Point Roberts businesses while helping save the lives of a lot of other Americans in Canada and other Canadians.

- 1) In early March, I wrote a letter to the White House Cc to others per the attached letter saying that there were over 1 million US Citizens living in Canada with no or little access to Covid vaccines. Since President Biden has said that the US will have a surplus supply soon to give every American the vaccine if they want it, I suggested that these surplus vaccines be given to US citizens living in Canada followed by Canadian citizens as supply allows. I do not know if my letter had any effect, but 2 weeks later President Biden announced that he would be giving Canada 1.5 million doses of the vaccine.
- 2) It occurs to me that Point Roberts, being landlocked but still part of the US is in a perfect situation to do this. You could ask your congressman and governor to send you more vaccines so you can carry out the humanitarian mission of vaccinating US citizens living in Canada (and BC). Everything would be done by appointment only so you would be able to control the number of people, the vaccine site would be right across the border in Point Roberts. Since you are landlocked, the White House would be able to easily get Trudeau to raise any border restrictions between Point Roberts and the US, and people going to Point Roberts can get a 15 minute quick Covid test in Point Roberts while waiting for their vaccine, and if negative, they can then go shopping or to a restaurant in Point Roberts before going back to Canada - maybe even give them a coupon/advertisement to do so.
- 3) You could send a copy of my letter to your congressman and governor as it was already sent to the White House, the premier of BC, and Trudeau. This gives you a reason to say that Point Roberts wants to do this and help save the lives of US citizens living in Canada using extra Pfizer and Moderna vaccines. Then as supplies increase, you can also give vaccines to other Canadians in BC. They will all come back for their 2nd shot and do more shopping and eating out in Point Roberts. This would also bring a lot of press and funding to Point Roberts.

Any you will save a lot of Americans and Canadians from dying.

Re: 1 million Americans plus dependents in Canada who are mostly unvaccinated

Dear Mr. Zients and Ms. Quillian:

There are approximately 1 million Americans living in Canada (many whom vote in US elections) plus their Canadian spouses and family members. Most of them have not yet been able to be vaccinated, not even with one dose, as Canada has been unable to get sufficient supplies of Covid-19 vaccines to do so. Most Americans living in Canada are originally from California, New York, and other states.

President Biden just announced that all adults in the U.S. should be able to be vaccinated by the end of May. Hence, it is likely that the vaccine supply in the US will exceed demand by the end of April or soon after, as many people will be either difficult to reach or are hesitant about getting vaccinated. Thus it will take time to get everyone in the US to be vaccinated. Since there will be excess vaccines available in the US during this time, I was wondering if it would then be possible for the US to ship sufficient doses of vaccine to Canada, especially to British Columbia, to vaccinate Americans living in Canada, their spouses, and their Canadian family members?

After this, it would also make sense to then provide vaccines, as supplies allows, to other Canadians as this would benefit both Canada and the US, two countries that have a long history of cooperating and working together.

Also, the Biden administration has issued a report that cited shortages of lipid nanoparticles among "urgent gaps" in the supply chain. Acuitas Therapeutics, located in Vancouver, BC, Canada, invented and holds the patent for the lipid nanoparticles used in the Pfizer vaccine. Thus perhaps the British Columbia, US, and Canadian governments could form a partnership to ensure a guaranteed supply of lipid nanoparticles and vaccines for both countries in the future. We really do not know yet when this pandemic will truly end, or if new vaccines and lipid nanoparticles will be needed to be developed in order to be able to end the pandemic.
