- > Here is the latest report from the UBC-SFU modelling group that's been embargoed for 16th June. They only sent it across to us this afternoon, so I've quickly created a summary for you both below:
- > They note that with recent VoC data, delta variant cases remain roughly constant, however they also note they have been growing in other jurisdictions including Alberta.
- > Modeling and projection updates indicate that first phase of reopening did not lead to an increase in cases and cases are likely to continue to decline with further re-opening (these scenarios do not include any potential vaccine escape due to delta variant)
- > The group indicates confusion in their interpretation of the VoC data and how to incorporate into their analyses. They highlight the recent large number of sequences uploaded to GISAID.

Dear Laura Ballance:

Thank you for the recent meeting and follow-up telephone call regarding Provincial Health Officer rules for re-opening of banquet halls. While the detailed rules are soon to be published, I can provide a high level summary of the main limitations.

However, first of all, I must acknowledge how difficult this has been for all those involved in banquet halls and their customers. Hopefully, with initial careful, small steps the banquet halls will be able to resume full operations later this summer.

As mentioned by Dr. Bonnie Henry, Minister Adrian Dix, and Premier John Horgan we are involved in a slow and careful re-opening of British Columbia. We need to move step-by-step to safely get back to where we want to be, with the slow going forward being important to ensure we do not go backwards from initial lifting of restrictions.

With regards to banquet halls, below is an overview of the main rules that will be in place June 15. Please note that the formal rules will be published later today or tomorrow, and it will be important to read those carefully to understand the all limitations, and to ensure all the rules are being followed:

- Capacity will be limited to 50 customers
- Access must be controlled
- Contact information of all people attending must be recorded
- Everyone must remain seated and stay in the same seat
- No more than six people can sit at a table
- Tables and chair must be spaced with two metres between the backs of the chairs
- There will be no self-serve food or liquor allowed
- Liquor can only be served to patrons who are seated
- · Dancing is not allowed and dance floors must be closed
- Customers must not sing or engage in karaoke
- Liquor sales must cease at midnight
- Customers must disperse immediately after an event and must not congregate with participants who are leaving the event or arriving for a subsequent event

As I mentioned, more details will be coming soon, but in the meantime, I hope that this assists in your preparations for re-opening banquet halls.

I will send you the final version of the order as soon as it is available.

Subject: Decision on shortening of interval between dose 1 and 2

I am following up our discussion Monday about moving to more permissive ability to give second doses before 49 days while still encouraging most people to remain at the longer interval given the increasing evidence that a longer interval gives stronger, longer lasting protection.

As we discussed, I worked through the options with the operations team to ensure we do not create backlogs in invites that would lead to longer wait times for those who have already passed 49 days. The modelling Terry presented shows that the large majority of dose two invites and bookings for this large group will be completed by the end of this week. In addition, they have let me know there is no way to allow people to book without the system automatically sending an invite to the entire group eligible. This would result in close to 200K invites being sent. If that happened this week that would again cause increased wait times and over booking of clinics.

Given the data on effectiveness as well as the operational considerations we have agreed to continue the current 49 day invitation/eligibility through this weekend and make the change to the system on Thursday next week (after walk in Wednesday). The new invite will say that we recommend that people receive dose 2 at about 42-49days but that they can receive it any time after 28 days. This will allow us to make vaccines available to more younger people sooner.

We will continue with the exceptions that we have agreed upon, including areas of high delta transmission and we have made that change for people in the Central Okanagan outbreak. Travel to the central OK is not a reason to reduce the interval as the advice from IH is not to travel there at this time unless you are fully vaccinated (14 days post dose 2). If people want early access for that reason they should be advised that travel is not recommended right now.
