## Key messages related to B.1.1.529 (Omicron) which has been declared as a Variant of Concern (VOC)

This variant has not yet been detected in the approximately 98,000 SARS-CoV-2 strains sequenced in BC but it has been detected in a number of countries outside of Africa.

Emerging variants are expected during the COVID pandemic. Parts of the world remain unvaccinated, and vaccination does not totally protect against transmission. Rather vaccines protect against severe disease.

Because the mRNA vaccines produce the entire spike protein, which is the part of the virus that is used to infect cells, it is very unlikely that any variant will interfere with the vaccine's ability to protect against severe disease.

The World Health Organization and countries around the world including Canada are carefully monitoring for more information on the transmissibility and disease severity related to B.1.1.529 (Omicron). All hands are on deck.

In BC we have very robust systems in place to monitor for vaccine protection in real time, and to perform surveillance for emerging variants including from travelers.
