For support of medical accommodation under the Provincial Health Officer COVID-19 Vaccination Status Information and Preventive Measures Order

| COVID-19 mRNA vaccines (Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna) COVID-19 viral vector vaccine (AstraZeneca) | History of an anaphylactic reaction to components of both mRNA and adenovirus vector vaccine (i.e., polyethylene glycol and polysorbate 80) |

| | Receipt of anti SARS-CoV-2 monoclonal antibodies or convalescent plasma for treatment or prevention of COVID-19 (except tocilizumab or sarilumab) – <i>defer for at least 90 days</i> |

| History of thrombosis with thrombocytopenia following a previous dose of an adenovirus vector COVID-19 vaccine. Such individuals may receive mRNA vaccine. | |
| History of capillary leak syndrome. Such individuals may receive mRNA vaccine. | |
| History of cerebral venous sinus thrombosis (CVST) with thrombocytopenia, unrelated to adenovirus vector COVID-19 vaccination, or heparin induced thrombocytopenia (HIT). Such individuals may receive mRNA vaccine. | |

Any deferral or contraindication related to an adverse event following immunization (AEFI) with COVID-19 vaccine must be reported for evaluation through the formal process for public health review and recommendations for subsequent doses. The medical accommodation form submission cannot override recommendations provided through the AEFI process.
