- 3 Cases are included if they were acute care, rehabilitation cases, or psychiatric services. (LEVEL is 'A' or 'R' or 'P')
- 4 Abortion records have been excluded from this report (hosp ^= 50, 51, 53 and abortion is null)
- 5 Stillborn and cadaveric donor cases are excluded (admit not in ('R', 'S'))
- 6 Cases discharged from hospital between April 1, 2016 and March 31, 2022 are included. Data is reported by fiscal year of hospital discharge.
- 7 Intensive Care Unit (ICU) cases are hospital stays with at least one ICU day. (ICUDAYS>0)
