#### **Request Response:**

The estimated total number of public sector health care workers as of April 1, 2021, was 216,020. As of April 1, 2022, it was 222,921.

Approximately, 2,500 employees were terminated due to non-compliance with the Hospital and Community COVID-19 Vaccination Status Information and Preventive Measures order.


