As mentioned, we are looking to bring a motion to amend the final agreement next week. Below are the coles notes

SUMMARY:

The Tsawwassen First Nation, Canada and the Province have signed the Tsawwassen First Nation Final Agreement Amending Agreement (Amending Agreement) to amend five Appendices of the Final Agreement containing the legal descriptions and parcel identifiers that describe the Tsawwassen Lands as of the April 3, 2009 Effective Date.

The Appendices did not accurately reflect the legal descriptions for the Tsawwassen Lands as they were registered in the Land Title Office on the Effective Date; the Amending Agreement will reconcile this discrepancy and is considered by the parties to be a housekeeping item.

In accordance with the Tsawwassen Final Agreement, the parties must ratify the Amending Agreement in the following order to give it effect: Tsawwassen First Nation, British Columbia, Canada.

The Tsawwassen First Nation Legislative Assembly passed a resolution to ratify the Amending Agreement during its November 7 and 9, 2017 legislative session.

Provincial ratification is provided by resolution (motion) of the Legislative Assembly.

Following notification by ministry staff of Tsawwassen's ratification, the Minister's office is working with the Government House Leader's office on the timing for the Minister to table the motion with the Clerk of the Legislature.

At the discretion of the Government House Leader, the motion can be called for debate after three sitting days of its tabling. As a motion of the Legislative Assembly is not a Bill, there is no debate in respect of the matter and interested members are only able to speak to the motion in general terms.
