Summary:

Coalition didn't specifically walk through any of the provided materials.

Verbal introductory comments Chief Leween, and then supplemental additions by other members of the Coalition.

MSF committed that Government wants an ongoing relationship with Coalition – want to work with them, wish to see them succeed.

Action: Gio to follow up with Niello to discuss process, goals/purpose of meetings and which agencies should co-attend with MIRR, will reach out to EAO specifically since Coalition had met with EAO earlier in the day.

Coalition just back from Ottawa; have had good discussions with other indigenous groups across Canada. Part of the funding they're getting from Federal Government will be used to share experiences with other jurisdictions. One group they will be speaking to and assisting is the Ring of Fire First Nations (Northern Ontario). Will be hosting an information session in PG on Nov 1/2.

Main issue was related to 211K request from Coalition for Kenney Dam Feasibility study.

Coalition reps relayed funding as important for them to demonstrate "proof of concept" that the coalition can assist members – this would be their first major initiative that members have identified. View the project as central to recognition in light of the damage of the dams to fish habitat, way of life, community relocation.

Discussion:

Even if there is no direct funding from Govt - opportunity for Coalition to pursue funding for the capacity building/feasibility through the Nechako Environmental Enhancement Fund (NEEF).

Coalition wanted the funding from Govt because: its a sign of reconciliation, consistent with UNDRIP and FPIC; funding from Govt will help boost their credibility and legitimacy.

Kathy Eichenberger, Jonathan and myself spend an extra few minutes after both Ministers and others left because of other commitments.

Kathy will follow up directly with David/Niello on the Dam issues if they wish to talk further.
