Dear Chief Tatoosh:

Thank you for your letters of July 9 and August 2, 2018, to Premier John Horgan and Minister Scott Fraser, respectively, regarding old-growth logging in Hupacasath Traditional Territory. As this falls under the purview of the Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development, I have been asked to respond and apologize for the delay.

Forest harvesting in the Nahmint watershed is guided by the Vancouver Island Land Use Plan, and the plan designates the Nahmint as a Special Management Zone. The management guidance for this area is focused on high biodiversity values, specifically maintaining old seral forest, forest connectivity, fish and wildlife habitat, and maintenance of recreational values. The Special Management Zone requires that 25 percent of forest in the Nahmint be retained as old and mature forest, and currently there is 70 percent mature and old forest in the Nahmint landscape unit.

Since the development of the Vancouver Island Land Use Plan, over 2,700 hectares of forest have been protected through the designation of draft Old Growth Management Areas (OGMAs), Wildlife Habitat Areas, Ungulate Winter Ranges, and Riparian Management Zones. There has been a great deal of work done to ensure that the draft OMGAs focus on protecting cedar throughout both the Nahmint and Great Central Lake landscape units. BC Timber Sales (BCTS) has also recently conducted a cedar assessment and identified over 200 old growth cedar trees (greater than 1 metre in diameter) that have now been protected to contribute to the biodiversity legacy in the valley and to provide future access to large cedar suitable for cultural purposes. Additional large cedar can be identified for protection through joint field work between Huapcasath and BCTS through the Cultural Heritage Assessment contract held with BCTS.

To further complement the measures noted above, in January 2018, BCTS established Best Management Practices for Coastal Legacy Trees. This protocol focuses on reserving large and unique Douglas Fir, Western Red Cedar, Sitka Spruce, and Yellow Cedar trees. This protocol was not in place when cut blocks were laid out for the recent harvesting in the Nahmint valley; however, in the future, BCTS intends to review all issued/sold and pending Timber Sale Licences that were developed prior to the implementation of the Legacy Tree Protocol. If any trees are identified that qualify under the protocol, BCTS will make best efforts to reserve them from harvest subject to safety, logistics and legal commitments.

This ministry is undertaking a coastal Big Tree pilot project to address the preservation of iconic big trees. The objective of this project is to assess if a policy should be developed to apply across the province. This protection will be in addition to the regulations and policies that address trees that have First Nations and cultural heritage values.

BCTS will continue to share road and cut block annual plans with Hupacasath First Nation in accordance with the consultation matrix outlined in the Hupacasath Forest Consultation and Revenue Sharing Agreement. BCTS is ready to discuss opportunities to work directly with Hupacasath on landscape level planning initiatives as well as present the Coastal Legacy Tree and Big Tree pilot protocols for Hupacasath review. In addition, the South Island Natural Resource District staff will continue to work with the Hupacasath to legally establish OGMAs within the Nahmint Valley.

The Province of British Columbia is committed to continue working with Hupacasath on forestry management and remains open to continued discussion and sharing of information.
