Canadian Coast Guard is lead agency;

- Other activated EOCs include City of Vancouver. NSEM's EOC has demobilized, however, EOC staff are supporting the Integrated ICP;
- Emergency Management BC's Provincial Coordination Team has been activated and deployed to Integrated ICP.
- Updated staffing plan under development working towards ICP staffing efficiencies.
- Transport Canada has confirmed source of the spill is secure. There is no more leaking.
- Overflights are being planned for today as conditions allow.
- Flyover results: sheen in vicinity of vessel. Estimated quantity of pollution left on the water (non-recoverable) is 0.3 litres.
- WCMRC (pollution response contractor) remains on-scene with multiple vessels patrolling.
- At 0805 hrs it was reported oil (the size / shape of a toonie to melon) drip or patch is appearing every five to ten minutes from the MV Marathassa.
- Water testing today at Siwash Rock, English Beach, Sandy Cove and near the casualty vessel.
- Anticipate commencing sediment sampling Tuesday, April 14th.
- Shore-line cleanup teams are being led by WCMRC in conjunction with SCAT (Shoreline Clean-Up Assessment Techniques) Teams from the Ministry of Environment, Coast Guard, Tsleil Wauthuth First Nation, Squamish First Nation and supported by impacted municipalities, with attention to environmentally sensitive areas. Two SCAT Teams are in the field, one team starting east of the First Narrows and the second team starting at New Brighton Park moving east.
- Shoreline cleanup crews have been assigned to John Lawson Park, Capilano River mouth and

New Brighton Park.

- 23 kilometers of shoreline have been assessed by the SCAT Teams. Approximately 3 km are showing signs of non-continuous impacts.
- Environment Canada and Ministry of Environment's Wildlife Technical Specialists are working with wildlife contractors to establish short/mid/long term action plans for wildlife rescue and rehabilitation. 3 oiled ducks (bullheads) have been captured and are currently being stabilized at the Wildlife Rescue Association.
- Unified Command has approved the funds and structure for extended wildlife rehabilitation.
- Approximately 15 20 birds (primarily ducks) have been identified as impacted with the majority
 of the affected birds in/near the pond at Vanier Park.
- Oiled birds have also been reported at Jericho Park and on the North Shore. Wildlife specialists are confirming those reports.
- Environment Canada Wildlife Technical Specialists are establishing a wildlife stabilization site at HMCS DISCOVERY in Stanley Park. Expect to be operational later today.
- Wildlife specialists are developing plans for the capture, stabilization and rehabilitation of oiled birds.
- Vancouver Aquarium is slowly turning water intake back on (water was turned off for 24 hours) and their ongoing testing of the water is good.
- Shoreline waste is being bagged on site and transported and staged on BCO #17 barge.
- WCMRC is establishing alternatives for cleaning vessels.
- Unified Command has approved test cleaning of the casualty to determine effectiveness. Fifty foot section of the casualty vessel to be cleaned. Tomorrow's activities will be determined by the results of today's tests. Test cleaning was successful.
- Cleaning of the hull of the MV Marathassa is continuing. Other identified vessels are being cleaned in order of scheduled ship movement. Speed of the cleaning process slightly hampered by weather / wave conditions in English Bay.
- Port Metro has confirmed schedule for movement of vessels out of the harbour and is conducting patrols of the inner harbour.
- Impacted local authorities and Vancouver Coastal Health need to coordinate on-going beach warnings and trigger points for removal of signs.
