SUMMARY OF EVIDENCE

The Edge Pub has operating hours of noon until 02:00 am Monday thru Saturday and 11:00 am until midnight on Sunday. On Friday October 5, 2007 @ 0245 hrs. (business day of Thursday October 4), Cst Jeff Muench, of the Kimberley RCMP, attended at the Edge Pub. He observed 4 patrons still consuming liquor. One was drinking from a beer bottle, one from a beer glass and the other two had cocktails. Two of the patrons exhibited gross signs of intoxication. The premises emptied at 0248 hrs. The licensee Andy Bamber was present. Cst Muench completed and served LPC B04734 on Mr. Bamber.

ALLEGED CONTRAVENTION(S)

Contravention Number B001464 : C Allow to consume beyond 1/2 hour after liquor service hours, Reg. s. 44(3)

Reasons for Recommending Enforcement Action

The hours when a licensed establishment may sell liquor are determined, in part, by community standards. Patrons who consume liquor and leave an establishment after the licensed hours of liquor service may disturb nearby residents and businesses. Selling liquor after hours also leads to unfair competition with other licensed establishments. This is not a case of being a few minutes over but a conscious act by the licensee.

Reasons for the Proposed Penalty

A period of suspension is recommended to encourage voluntary compliance from the licensee in future. The recommended period of suspension is the minimum within the penalty range for a contravention of this type.

Therefore;

For the alleged contravention of Allow to consume beyond 1/2 hour after liquor service hours, Reg. s. 44(3) (Contravention Notice Number B001464) set out in this notice, the enforcement hearing advocate will recommend to the general manager at an enforcement hearing that a suspension penalty of 4 days is warranted. This recommended suspension penalty falls within the penalty range set out in schedule 4 of the Regulation for a first contravention.

Suspension procedures

A Liquor Control and Licensing Branch inspector or police officer will attend at your establishment prior to opening time on the first day of the suspension to:

Responsibility of licensee

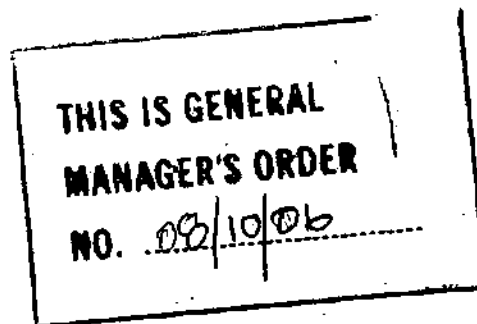

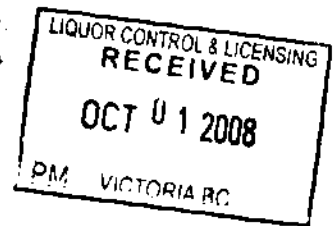



SUMMARY OF EVIDENCE

On September 07, 2008 at approx. 0125 hrs Kimberley RCMP responded to a complaint of an assault at the Edge Pub in Kimberley, B.C. The assault is alleged to have occurred because one male patron took exception to another male patron offering a female (the aggressor's girlfriend) a drink during a bikini contest being held at the premises. As part of the investigation into the assault, it became known that the female s.22

s.22

On September 22, 2008, Liquor Inspector Dreilich was able to speak to s.22 She advises she went to the bar with 3 other patrons between 2100 and 2200 hrs. and left at closing. She was not checked for identification at any time. They entered through the main doors off of the parking lot. She remembers one person working at the door but felt there were two door staff working. She does not have any fake or altered identification.

ALLEGED CONTRAVENTION(S)

Contravention Number B014881 : C Minors in premises, s. 35

Reasons for Recommending Enforcement Action

Minors are restricted from liquor primary establishments to avoid being sold or served liquor and exposing them to adult entertainment. Permitting minors to enter and remain in a premise is a significant public safety issue because of: the effects of alcohol abuse on growing bodies and developing minds, the effects on individuals and society of irresponsible drinking behaviour learned at an early age, a minor's lack of capacity to metabolize alcohol in the same manner as an adult, therefore, liquor has a more intoxicating effect on minors and liquor is a significant factor in many crimes committed by youth, including serious driving offences, assaults, sexual assault and theft.

Reasons for the Proposed Penalty

A suspension penalty is being recommended to ensure future voluntary compliance. Although the licensee appears to be trying to comply it is apparent that not all staff understand the serious public safety issues created when minors are permitted to enter and remain in a premise. It is felt that the minimum penalty for this contravention will help to ensure all staff comply. The penalty falls within the range set out at Schedule 4 of the Regulations, Item 3.

Therefore;

For the alleged contravention of Minors in premises, s. 35 (Contravention Notice Number B014881) set out in this notice, the enforcement hearing advocate will recommend to the general manager at an enforcement hearing that a suspension penalty of 4 days is warranted. This recommended suspension penalty falls within the penalty range set out in schedule 4 of the Regulation for a first contravention.

The suspension will be served starting on a Saturday and will continue on successive business days until completed.

THE PROCEDURES

An enforcement hearing may be scheduled to determine whether the alleged contravention(s) occurred and the appropriate penalty, if any, that should be imposed. You can contest the contravention(s) and/or the proposed penalty at the enforcement hearing.

Please Note: If a penalty is warranted, the General Manager may;

- Impose a suspension of the liquor license for a period of time;

This requirement is intended to provide local businesses and residents with reasonable notice of this application and the nature of the requested changes. It also provides the General Manager with an opportunity to assess local resident's views through correspondence received as a result of this process. Only letters received directly to the branch from local businesses and residents will be considered. A decision whether or not to grant the change of hours will be based on this assessment.

The public notice will be obtained by placement of a sign and by newspaper notice. The guidelines for public notification are attached.
