They will probably be required to ferry others over such as the Coroner, Police and eventually bring the bodies back.

This eve the ECC received a call from Batina (Pemberton EPC) who was wondering if Hydro could come out and remove debris from trees.

After getting more details from the EPC, I explained to Batina that once the deceased have been removed our involvement would end and the responsibility for clean up would transition to BC Parks and the Park Operator..

Batina advised that Pemberton Fire was still on scene doing a camp ground sweep as some campers were traumatized. I advised Batina that if campers needed support that BC Parks could arrange this with the RCMP and victim services.

I have spoken with Jen Pitnikoff (BC Parks Supervisor for Pemberton Area) and also advised her that the remainder of the clean up would need to be coordinated by BC Parks and the Park Operator. She is aware that we have arranged for a unit crew out of Pemberton to assist. I advised Jen that if she needed more support that she should contact Coastal Fire Centre directly. I also gave her the # for the ECC, in case she needs to speak with me further.

Pemberton SAR will be back out Sun am possibly with a HETSt team from Whistler to recover one of the deceased that was unable to be recovered today.

It appears that there is quite a bit of debris spread out over a large area that is not required by the TSB.

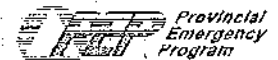

Date of Incident: June 29, 2013

Incident Location: Nairn Falls Campground – Hwy 99

- ECOMM began fielding 911 calls of a mid-air plane crash between a Cessna and glider above the Nairn Falls Campground at approx. 12:22pm
- Report that the glider crashed at the north end of the campground and the Cessna on the other side of Green River in forested areas. Fire at both sites. Debris falling over campground sites. Campground at full capacity due to Canada Day Long Weekend.
- Emergency Agencies on scene: Pemberton Fire Rescue, RCMP, BCAS, Pemberton Search & Rescue. Initially Pemberton Wildfire Management Branch on scene; however, were cleared when no threat to wildfire was reported.
- Initial reports – no survivors of crash, no reported injuries on the ground through the campsite, lots of debris throughout campground.
- Emergency Program Coordinator was notified to activate EOC – Level 1 at 2:14pm to assist with resources request for trail closure and food coordination for Pemberton Fire responders. No evacuation of campers is anticipated by RCMP. EMBC had been notified and issued a TASK number under PSAR.



This eve the ECC received a call from Batina (Pemberton EPC) who was wondering if Hydro could come out and remove debris from trees.

After getting more details from the EPC, I explained to Batina that once the deceased have been removed our involvement would end and the responsibility for clean up would transition to BC Parks and the Park Operator..

Batina advised that Pemberton Fire was still on scene doing a camp ground sweep as some campers were traumatized. I advised Batina that if campers needed support that BC Parks could arrange this with the RCMP and victim services.

I have spoken with Jen Pltnikoff (BC Parks Supervisor for Pemberton Area) and also advised her that the remainder of the clean up would need to be coordinated by BC Parks and the Park Operator. She is aware that we have arranged for a unit crew out of Pemberton to assist. I advised Jen that if she needed more support that she should contact Coastal Fire Centre directly. I also gave her the # for the ECC, in case she needs to speak with me further.

Pemberton SAR will be back out Sun am possibly with a HETSt team from Whistler to recover one of the deceased that was unable to be recovered today.

It appears that there is quite a bit of debris spread out over a large area that is not required by the TSB.
