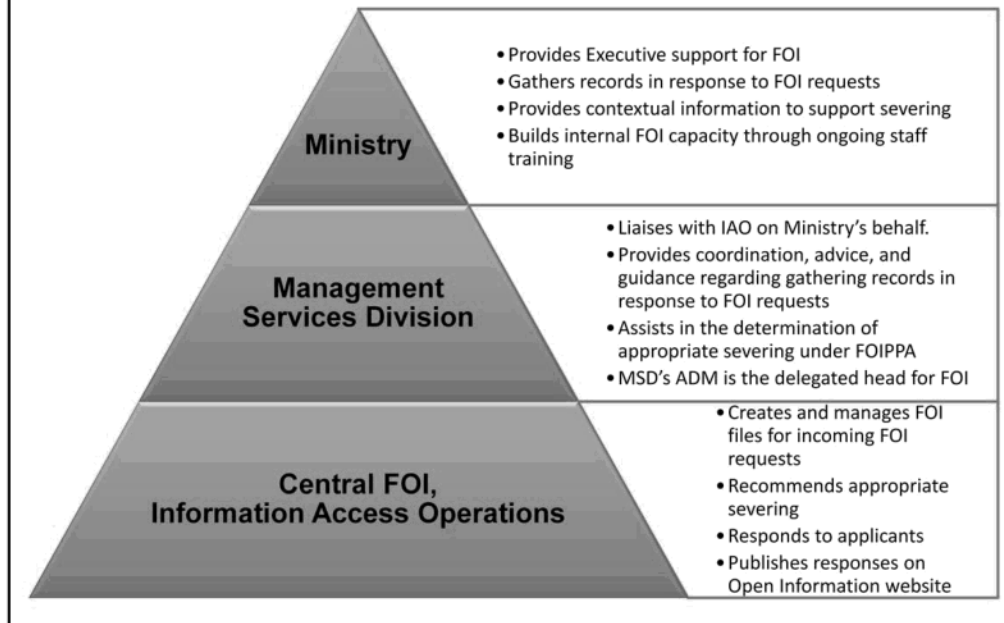

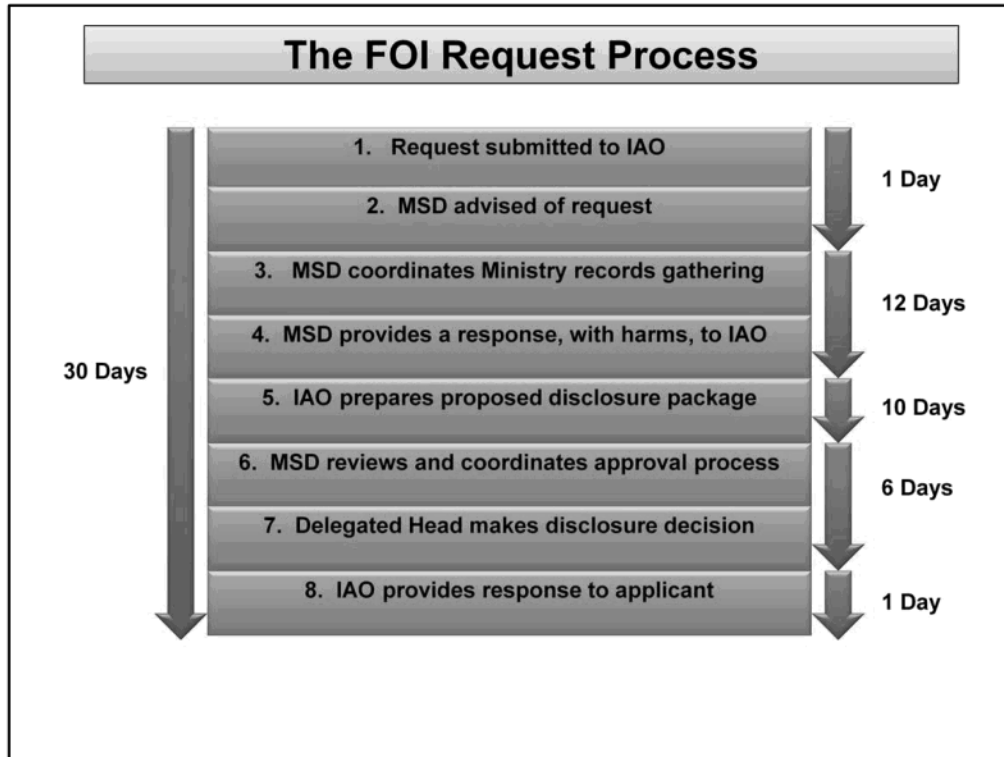

The Role of Management Services Division

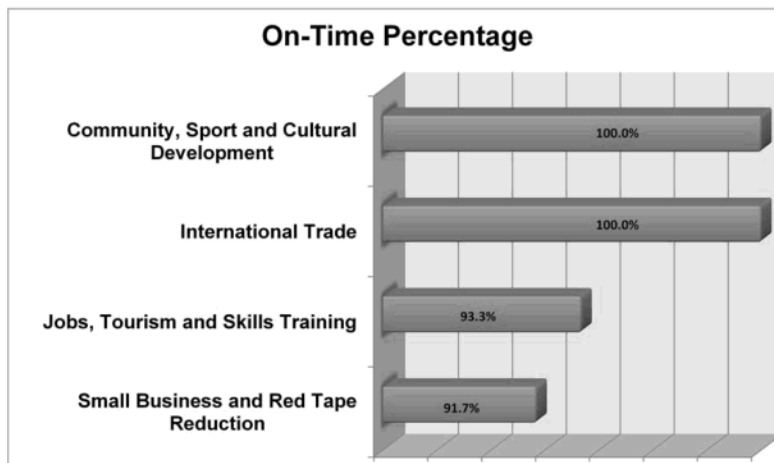


- MSD liaises with Central FOI with respect to FOIPPA
- MSD's role is to provide advice and guidance regarding all stages of FOI requests
 - The stages are shown in more detail on the next slide



- This is a high level overview of the FOI request process
- MSD acts as a central point of contact between Central FOI (Information Access Operations) and the ministries
- This includes:
 - determining which program areas must be searched,
 - providing guidance on the scope of a request,
 - reviewing all severing recommendations, and
 - managing the approval process

FOI Performance in the Economy Sector Fiscal Year 2017/18

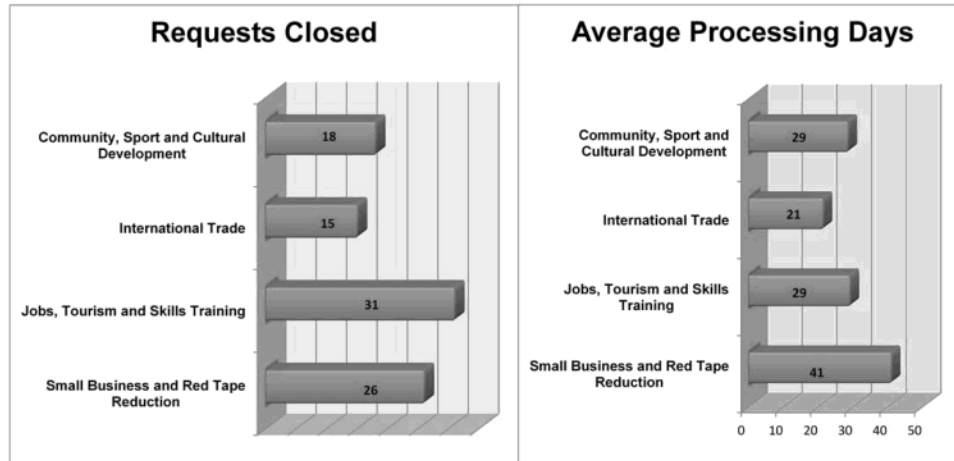


- Last fiscal year, government closed approximately 4,500 personal requests and 5,400 general requests
 - Totalling over 1.8M pages of records

Data below is accurate to July 14th

- Government-wide percent on time is currently 90%
- All of our ministries are performing better than the average
- Only three ministries are currently at 100%
 - We have two of those three ministries
 - The other is the Ministry of Natural Gas Development

FOI Performance in the Economy Sector Fiscal Year 2017/18



- Last fiscal year, the Economy Sector closed 585 requests (Government closed approximately 9,900)
 - This is up from just over 500 in FY2015/16 (Government closed approximately 8,800)

Data below is accurate to July 14th

- This year-to-date, the Economy Sector has already closed 90 requests
 - Not accounted for above, are the monthly proactive disclosures of Ministers' and Deputy Ministers' calendars and travel expenses
 - and the monthly proactive disclosure of a summary of directly-awarded contracts
- Government-wide average processing time is currently 38 days
- Only eight ministries have an average processing time of 30 days or less
 - We have three of those eight ministries
