Zailda Chan, President

Zailda Chan is Local 40's newly elected president. She holds the dual distinction of being the first Chinese-Canadian union president in British Columbia and the first woman elected president of Local 40. Ms. Chan joined the union as an organizer in 2008.

Looking ahead to the next five years, Ms. Chan's top priority is organizing hospitality workers to amplify workers' voices and to raise industry standards in BC's most important business sector. She will continue to build on Local 40's success at winning good contracts for members, while leading efforts to create better jobs for food service workers who work at Vancouver International Airport, drive major hotel-wide bargaining in downtown Vancouver this summer, prepare for hotel bargaining in Victoria, Prince George, Nanaimo and Kelowna, and continue to support ongoing contract fights at UNBC and Victoria Airport.

The great-granddaughter and grandniece of Vancouver railway workers from China — most of whom paid the "head tax" a century ago — Ms. Chan's journey to the top of UNITE HERE Local 40 began at home. She moved to Canada with her parents and siblings at 13 years old. Emigrating from Venezuela — having left earlier from one of China's poorest provinces — Ms. Chan's parents took on garment work from home at ten cents per piece. Ms. Chan took her family's early experiences of racism, poverty and under-employment, and built her commitment to fight for fairness, dignity and respect for every family.

Prior to joining Local 40, Ms. Chan was a community organizer. She is a graduate of Simon Fraser University.
