I am responding to your email of May 17, 2019, addressed to Premier John Horgan, the Honourable Katrine Conroy, MLA for Kootenay West, and me, in which you outline your concerns regarding allegations surrounding the former Clerk of the Legislative Assembly.

While I appreciate receiving your concerns, I would like to clarify that as Attorney General I do not direct the police in any ongoing investigations and generally do not become involved in individual prosecutions. The BC Prosecution Service (BCPS) is responsible for the conduct and supervision of criminal prosecutions and appeals in British Columbia.

The matter you raise is currently being investigated by the RCMP. On October 1, 2018, two Special Prosecutors were appointed to provide legal assistance and advice to the RCMP in the matter. You can learn more from the media statement (https://www2.gov.bc.ca/assets/gov/law-crime-and-justice/criminal-justice/prosecution-service/media-statements/2018/18-23-bcps-appoints-2-sp-re-bc-leg-staff.pdf) that was released by the BCPS on November 28, 2018. As the police investigation is ongoing, the BCPS is unable to share further information at this time.


