#### \$25 Positioning Move Rate:

#### **Parties**

- The province established a working group of 3 company representatives, BCTA and 3 labour representatives (UTA, Unifor and Teamsters) to come up with an agreed-upon definition for the \$25 positioning move. At the first working group meeting on May 15, there was agreement for the \$25 positioning move rate:
  - The Working Group recommends that a \$25 Positioning Efficiency Fee be paid to drivers in addition to each on-dock and off-dock container move, for both empty and laden containers, listed as a separate line item fee, associated to each container move. (One time flat \$25 fee)
- Since that meeting, 6 of the 7 working group members indicated their support for the definition. Cascadia is reconfirming their support this week prior to a working group meeting scheduled for Friday June 7 to finalize the
  recommended definition and signed endorsement by the working group members.
- Following the May 15 working group meeting, one party has indicated it does not support implementation of
  the \$25 positioning move, to be applied to all paid container moves (on-dock or off-dock). It's reasoning for not
  supporting this definition is that in their view it does not address the fact there are a low percentage of doubleended moves (where a pick up and drop off of a full or empty container is coordinated, so the driver gets two
  paid moves). They want drivers to get paid a \$25 positioning move for all empty chassis or bobtail moves.
  (Multiple \$25 fees for every seperate move on the trip)
- The \$25 positioning rate agreed to by 6 of 7 working group members is consistent with the Commissioner's
  recommendation (and has been endorsed by the Commissioner), and compensates drivers for the high
  percentage of paid trips that involve an empty chassis or bobtail move.

#### Move rates and regulations to commissioner's office:

- In April 2019 the Minister of Transportation and Infrastructure announced the implementation of 10 of the 12 recommendations by July 1, 2019.
- To implement the Commissioner's recommendations within the timeframes committed to by government is to repeal the rates described and enable the Container Trucking Commissioner to set rates by order effective July 1, 2019.
- Repealing the rates will fulfill the original intent of the Act and the objectives underlying the establishment of
  the Office of the Container Trucking Commissioner, which was for the province to set initial rates in 2014, with
  the ability to then hand over rate-setting power to the Commissioner.
