Hi Danine and Angelo,

My team recent became aware of an initiative between the federal government and Canadian Labour Congress to provide a pathway to permanent residence for "out of status" construction workers in the Greater Toronto Area. "Out of status" mean they came to Canada legally, but their work permit or visitor visa lapsed so they currently do not have legal status in the country.
