My personal experience in BC, as am sure for thousands of other BC residents, is that most, if not all mechanical shops working with ICBC overcharge between 200 to 800% for spare parts over and above their purchase costs. Example: yesterday a single car suspension part which can be bought, legally and with warranty, delivered to my domicile was about \$55; cost at a local shop (who shall remain unnamed for the time being) \$176, a mark-up, paid by ICBC of about 320%

If you put thousands of small transactions like this together, in a year, this overcharging (price gouging?) probably amounts to several million dollars. Which us, ICBC clients, are being forced to pay






