I'll see if I can put something together for you including an org chart. In terms of my responsibilities, I oversee all licensing and registration activity at the AGCO which includes:

Gaming – corporate (suppliers and operators), gaming workers, lottery retailers, charitable lottery licensing

Alcohol – establishments (restaurants, bars etc), manufacturers, grocery, other retail and special occasion permits

Racing – workers, owners, breeders, racetracks, teletheatres

I also have our customer service team in my shop. So, you will soon see my group is quite large but we do a lot of different things and at very high volumes. We use a risk-based licensing/registration approach for all our lines of business.

All that being said, we are going through a transformation of our own mainly brought on by our entry into digital service delivery (applying for licenses online vs. paper) which will bring many efficiencies \$.16 In addition, while we are currently structured by line of



This memorandum outlines the initial scope of the AGCO's review of Great Canadian Gaming Corporation's ("GCGC") compliance with its regulatory obligations in Ontario as a result of recent information reported in the press regarding River Rock Casino in B.C.

GCGC is the principal shareholder of Ontario Gaming East Limited Partnership ("OGELP") and Ontario Gaming GTA Limited Partnership ("OGGLP") and Ontario Gaming West GTA Limited Partnership ("OGWGLP"). OGELP is the current Operator of the three gaming sites in the OLG's East Bundle (Shorelines 1000 Islands, Shorelines Kawartha Downs and Shorelines Belleville). OGELP assumed operations of the first two properties on January 11, 2016, opening the casino in Belleville on January 11, 2017 and on January 23, 2018, GCGC transitioned into its role as the Operator of the three gaming sites in the GTA Bundle (Woodbine, Ajax Downs and Great Blue Heron). In December 2017, OGWGLP was announced as the Operator of OLG's West GTA Bundle (Brantford, Mohawk, Flamboro and Grand River).

Background

In April 2014, OGELP was shortlisted by the OLG for the East Gaming Bundle. In June 2014, the AGCO engaged PwC to conduct an Eligibility Assessment of OGELP. The Eligibility Assessment was comprised of a corporate overview, a financial due diligence and a regulatory compliance evaluation. The OPP conducted a Due Diligence investigation into the key employees of OGELP, including a criminal records check, credit check, financial, income taxes, civil checks and jurisdictional scan.

In October 2014, PwC visited 4 GCGC gaming sites in B.C. as part of its assessment, one of which was River Rock Casino. While on site, PwC reviewed GCGC's AML practices and confirmed that AML controls were in place. PwC submitted its report to the AGCO in November 2014. The report did not identify any significant concerns with regard to AML. PwC did not identify any significant residual risks.

In September 2015, the OLG selected OGELP for the East Bundle. OGELP was issued its Registration as an Operator in January 2016, and shortly thereafter transitioned into its role as the Operator of the sites within the East Bundle.

Focus on adherence to Standards and activities that GCGC/OGELP is accountable for in relation to OLG's AML Program. The activities that will be assessed include training; management-staff alignment on how AML concerns are handled and escalated; operationalization of AML policies and procedures within the sites and risk factors as it relates to their Ontario operations. Where compliance issues are identified, AFI will assess if ineffective and inadequate governance arrangements was a potential root cause. These findings are to be shared with Mr. LeBlanc as an input to his overall governance review.

Licensing and Registration Branch

- Continue to liaise with counterparts in GPEB to obtain registration/licensing updates.
- GPEB will be renewing GCGC's registration in April 2018, coordinate any due diligence activities where appropriate.

Reporting structure and Timelines

The review team should provide bi-weekly status reports outlining progress of work/review and related observations and findings. Prior to completion of the Final Report, the review team will present a Draft Report to the AGCO Oversight Committee.
