All,

Both Grand Chief Joe Norton (of the Mohawk Council of Kahnawake) and myself have been reading with sadness how the perception of the administration of justice in Canada for Indigenous peoples is not being carried out. According to the Globe and Mail today, Indigenous peoples make up 4% of the population and 27% of inmates in our correctional institutions. This trend cannot continue.

I have just read the Supreme Court of Canada **R v Gladue** 1999 ruling and feel Canada and the provinces can do a better job with Indigenous legal proceedings and in particular sentencing as it pertains to section 718.2 (<https://qweri.lexum.com/calegis/rsc-1985-c-c-46-en#!fragment/sec718.2>). My firm is now partnering with Grand Chief Joe Norton's community which is located just outside of Montreal. Kahnawake has built the largest data centre on sovereign territory in the world. We refer to it as the National Indigenous Data Centre (NIDC). The NIDC has been successfully providing hosting and data centre solutions primarily in the online gaming industry for 20+ years. The community is now pivoting and offering IT and data centre solutions for all areas related to supporting Indigenous communities. They have more than 400 full time staff and a data centre with \$100 million in infrastructure / investment.

We feel there is an opportunity to provide the province of British Columbia and in particular your Ministry with an Indigenous led solution for all of your courts related to "Gladue Reports".

Our infrastructure is Canadian Federal Government Protected B certified. (Data in Transit)

A division of Forrest Green, eDisclosure.org, has been supporting police departments and crown attorneys with Major Case management solutions leveraging Adobe PDF eForms for more than a decade. We are meeting with BC Chiefs of Police earlier in the week and would like to set up a meeting with you when we are in Victoria for Indigenous Child Welfare meetings.

We feel it is an appropriate time for a dialog with an Indigenous led technology consortium to discuss solutions that will improve the perception and actual administration of justice.

It would be our desire to work closely with Indigenous leaders from BC. We are very fond of Chief Byron Louis and have had the pleasure of meeting with him and his community at the Okanagan Indian Band last year (photo below from Ottawa Conference). I have copied him on this email.

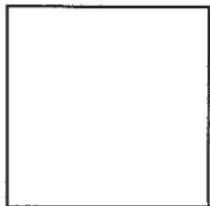

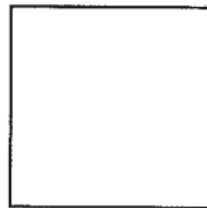

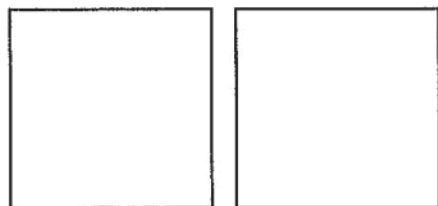
