

Both Grand Chief Joe Norton (of the Mohawk Council of Kahnawake) and myself have been reading with sadness how the perception of the administration of justice in Canada for Indigenous peoples is not being carried out. According to the Globe and Mail today, Indigenous peoples make up 4% of the population and 27% of inmates in our correctional institutions. This trend cannot continue.

I have just read the Supreme Court of Canada **R v Gladue** 1999 ruling and feel Canada and the provinces can do a better job with Indigenous legal proceedings and in particular sentencing as it pertains to section 718.2 (<a href="https://qweri.lexum.com/calegis/rsc-1985-c-c-46-en#!fragment/sec718.2">https://qweri.lexum.com/calegis/rsc-1985-c-c-46-en#!fragment/sec718.2</a>). My firm is now partnering with Grand Chief Joe Norton's community which is located just outside of Montreal. Kahnawake has built the largest data centre on sovereign territory in the world. 


