

False Creek Yacht Club, 1661 Granville St., Vancouver, does not have a liquor primary licence, but sells liquor in its club house to the public, and puts on events such as weddings, company parties, etc. for revenue, even though neither the caterer nor the club has public liquor licenses.

The police don't have the capacity to determine what the appropriate licenses are for a private club.

Is the Liquor Control and Licensing Branch not the correct monitoring and enforcement agency when a club goes beyond its private liguor licensing and services the public as well? Surely that's not fair to the liquor establishments that pay the appropriate fees for appropriate public licenses. If you are not the correct monitoring agency, could you forward this to the appropriate agency?

Thank you for writing with your enquiry. If a private club wishes to serve liquor to the public as well as to its members and guests, it may apply for a liquor primary licence (if they have a focus on beverage service, entertainment or hospitality) or a food primary licence (if they have a focus on food service).

A private club could also apply for a liquor primary club licence. This licence restricts the sale and service of liquor to members and guests only. There are some additional privileges for liquor primary club licences - they have less restrictive alternate use rules, and they may allow members to keep liquor for personal consumption in their locker in a locker room. For more information about these special privileges, see section 7.7.12 of the Licensing Policy Manual (http://www.pssg.gov.bc.ca/lclb/docs-forms/lclb207-policy-licensing.pdf).
