As discussed in our meeting earlier today, we have been working with the indigenous advisors at the Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development (FLNR) to clarify which First Nations UBC needs to engage based on territorial claims and to determine the degree of engagement based on available strength of claim information and analysis. The indigenous advisors from FLNR have confirmed our initial understanding of the following First Nations to be potentially affected by a decision based on consultative area database boundaries and the recommended appropriate level of consultation:

- 7. Skawahlook First Nation **notification only**
- 8. Seabird Island Band- notification only
- 9. Penelakut Tribe notification only
- 10. Halalt First Nation **notification only**
- 11. Ts'uubaa-asatx First Nation (Lake Cowichan First Nation) notification only
- 12. Stz'uminus First Nation notification only
- 13. Lyackson First Nation notification only
- 14. Cowichan Tribes notification only
- 15. Snuneymuxw First Nation notification only
