BC HOUSING BRIEFING NOTE

TOPIC: PROJECTS IN DEVELOPMENT AND UNDER CONSTRUCTION

INTRO

- As of March 31, 2017, more than 6,700 units are in development or under construction across the province through a range of programs.
- In 2016/17, four new funding programs were announced: the Provincial Investment in Affordable Housing (PIAH), Investment in Housing Innovation (IHI), Social Infrastructure Fund (SIF), and Mental Health Housing (MHH).

CURRENT FUNDING PROGRAMS

Provincial Investment in Affordable Housing (PIAH)

- In February 2016, the Province announced \$355 million to construct and renovate more than 2,000 social housing units across the province under the Provincial Investment in Affordable Housing (PIAH) program.
- Approximately \$50 million of this investment has been earmarked for Aboriginal housing.

Investment in Housing Innovation (IHI)

- In September 2016, the Province announced its commitment to fund \$500 million to create almost 2,900 new units of housing under the Investment in Housing Innovation (IHI).
- These projects will be non-profit owned and operated. From the \$500 million investment, \$300 million was granted to non-profit housing providers in 2016/17 towards the capital costs of the projects and \$200 million will be used as a revolving fund to provide construction financing of these projects over the construction period.

Social Infrastructure Funding (SIF)

- In June 2016, the provincial and federal governments announced the 2016 Social Infrastructure Fund (SIF) Agreement under the Agreement for Investment in Affordable Housing (IAH) to improve the quality and increase the supply of affordable rental housing in the province.
- Under this agreement, the federal government will contribute \$150 million and the Province will contribute \$63 million over two years (April 1, 2016 to March 31, 2018).

Mental Health Housing (MHH)

- The Province committed \$65 million (\$50 million in 2016/17 and \$15 million in 2017/18) to fund the purchase and renovation of 364 units of affordable rental housing for low to moderate income individuals with mental health or substance use issues across the province.
- The 18 projects will be operated by non-profit housing societies.

CURRENT FINANCING PROGRAM

Community Partnership Initiatives

- The Community Partnership Initiatives (CPI) program provides interim construction financing and/or arranges long-term financing for eligible partners to create affordable housing developments that do not need ongoing operating subsidies.
- Through CPI, BC Housing is able to provide financing with favourable rates as well as advice and referrals to partnership opportunities.

PROJECTS IN DEVELOPMENT OR UNDER CONSTRUCTION

- The projects in the chart below are funded and/or financed under different programs, including the following: the Provincial Investment in Affordable Housing (PIAH), Investment in Housing Innovation (IHI), Social Infrastructure Fund (SIF), Mental Health Housing (MHH) and Community Partnership Initiatives (CPI).
