Subject: SAFER and RAP Information

Below is some information on SAFER and RAP:

Rental Assistance (RAP) and the Shelter aid for Elderly Renters (SAFER) make housing more affordable for low income families and seniors renting in the private market. There has not been a funding change to either of these programs in a number of years. This has left many families falling just out of RAP eligibility or seniors on SAFER still not getting by.

Budget 2018 invests \$116 million over three years to increase the average benefit under RAP and SAFER. Here are the changes made:

RAP – Households making up to \$40,000 are now eligible. Prior to this budget only households making up to \$35,000 were eligible for RAP. Recipients can also expect on average \$800 more per year.

SAFER – Recipients on SAFER can now expect on average \$930 more per year.

Many of you have been in contact with constituents who may have fallen shy of being eligible for RAP, or are on SAFER and still struggling. I highly advise you reach out to those constituents again to make sure they are aware of the changes. Changes to SAFER and RAP didn't make the headlines like the new speculation tax or increased foreign buyers tax did so many people won't be aware of it.
