While the intent to provide affordable housing might be laudable, the effect is to make housing in Richmond more expensive than its neighbours, forcing Richmond residents to buy homes elsewhere. Does the Province have any intention to address this by standardizing these sorts of programs across municipalities?

Selina Robinson was elected as the MLA for Coquitlam-Maillardville in 2013 and re-elected in 2017. She is the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing.

Selina served as the Official Opposition spokesperson for mental health and addictions, seniors, local government and sports.

As a former city councillor, Selina fought to protect the health of children and families by introducing a local ban on cosmetic pesticides, and worked to improve access for people with disabilities as chair of the Coquitlam Universal Access-Ability Advisory Committee.

Prior to being elected, Selina had a home-based family therapy practice, was the Director of Development for SHARE Family and Community Services and was a Counselling Instructor and Program Developer at the University of British Columbia's Life and Learning Centre and Vancouver Community College.
