Question 1: Is there step by steps instructions on the paperwork that you need to complete in order to go through dispute resolution?

- There are no step by step instructions on the paperwork itself for example if a person was filing a paper
 application for dispute resolution at a Service BC office they would not find any instructions as to how to
 complete the application.
- However, the Ministry's website has a wealth of information on the dispute resolution process, "how to videos" and also the Solution Explorer is an intuitive and user friendly tool to use – even for novices at filing for dispute resolution.
 - Here is the link: https://www2.gov.bc.ca/gov/content/housing-tenancy/residential-tenancies

Question 2: Does the 10 day notice (first one) for failure to pay rent need to be served somehow specifically?

- Yes; ALL notices must be served in accordance with the Act.
 - Section 88 of the Residential Tenancy Act (the Act) describes how any notices can be served on the
 other party. There are several options for service and as long as the individual follows these options,
 they will have met the service requirements.
 - O Please keep in mind that it is important for anyone serving a notice of any kind to another party, to make sure they have proof that they have done so. Some of the residential tenancy branch processes require a specific "proof of service" so it is important for anyone to get in the habit of either having a witness with them or be able to provide proof that the notice was served. The easiest way to serve with proof is of course, registered mail.
 - If someone is serving hearing documents once they have filed for dispute resolution, they must serve
 those specific documents in very restrictive ways: either in person or by registered mail. These "special"
 documents are identified in Section 89 of the Act.

Up until around 1972 as I understand it persons were allowed to depreciate apartment buildings against personal income. This turned out to be an incentive to build rental housing. That tax benefit was undone by the Federal Government around then. However at the time there was a reasonable supply of affordable rental housing on a

national basis as well as BC. Thus over the next 45 years the construction in the lower mainland has been homes and condos. The incentive to build rental buildings disappeared. Condos were perhaps more affordable 10 years ago and satisfied the need of renters at that time. Now monthly rents in older buildings are less costly then owning comparable condominiums. There has only been a few rental buildings constructed during this long period and the market rents are generally unaffordable. Most rental buildings that one sees in Lower Mainland that are still standing and have relatively affordable rents were built during the 60s when the incentives were in place. May I suggest that your government collaborate with the Federal Government to create tax incentives for the construction of rental housing. The objectives are to increase supply and and thus keep rents from escalating. Perhaps the model of the 60's will work now. I hope you appreciate my comments come from a lay person and I realize not all facts may be factual.

It is totally unfair for your government to create this new "school tax" based on assessed value of homes over 3 million through no fault of the owners. A lot of people who purchased their homes 30-40 years ago are retired and will have to come up with thousands of dollars. Where are they supposed to find that money. It is not good enough to state defer the tax. It becomes a debt. What if a financial catastrophe happens (not far fetched with Trump) and we can't sell our homes without the values dropping say 50%? It is difficult enough to have seen Vancouver's municipal taxes rise substantially during last 5 years. Subject: Towards aBC Community Land Trust Act

As requested, Bowinn, here are the specific measures we'd like to see included in a draft *BC Community Land Trust Act* and the immediate steps we can take to make land trusts a reality.

A) WHY WE NEED LAW REFORM

The legislation is necessary to create a new, non-market housing sector to deliver permanently affordable housing for British Columbians. It would allow British Columbians to make sure that they can buy, rent or coop

their homes. CLTs could also provide small businesses spaces to rent heard to the income of their business. Just as the province legislated the *Credit Union Incorporation Act* to create and regulate a made-in-BC financial services sector, the *BC Community Land Trust Act* would safeguard the public interest in potentially sizeable non-market real estate holding. The CLT sector would advance the use of land for homes and families, curbing the use of real estate for global commodification and money laundering.

The *BC Community Land Trust Act* would make the province a national innovator in using land trusts to manage both the supply and demand sides of the housing crisis.

On the supply side, it would allow municipalities and other levels of government, faith communities, family estates etc to transfer land out of the for-profit real estate market. For example, the District of West Vancouver purchased a sizeable parcel of land from Vancouver Coastal Health to provide, as Mayor Mike Smith explained it to me, "affordable housing for families". The District is presently investigating how this land might be used as a land trust, but is showing some reluctance given the absence of robust legislation. British Columbians who do not have heirs could bequeath their homes to a CLT, allowing a single-family house to be transformed into housing for two or more households. Further, the Archdiocese of Vancouver is perhaps the largest community-based land holder in the Lower Mainland. It is under pressure to liquidate assets in deals with private developers in order to fund schools. CLTs would open a new avenue for the Archdiocese and other community-based land holders to leverage their real estate portfolios in ways that advance their commitments to housing justice.

This would over time create a potentially significant province-wide stock of non-market real estate anchored in the public policy goal of affordable, inclusive housing for British Columbians of ever walk of life. As the size of the non-market real estate sector grows, in addition to the direct provision of affordable housing, I anticipate it would have a dampening impact on inflation in the costs of renting or buying homes in the for-profit market. The sector would also act as an important buffer for families against a weakening or collapse of the for-profit real estate sector.

The distinctive feature of a land trust, setting it apart from the distribution of land by the for-profit real estate market and housing coops, is the structure of its governance and public accountability:





Hi Tim, I have been working with local FLNRO staff on a homeless camp at Borden Creek in the Chilliwack River Valley. Other encampments that are far larger have been removed from the Valley by cooperation between RCMP and FLNRO staff, but this one has been in place for about 7 months now with no end in sight. We have heard that these folks (who have movable recreation vehicles onsite) found private land on which to reside, but they refuse to move.

Locals attribute to it thefts in the area, open drug use, an incident of violence, general intoxication, improper disposal of human waste, unsightliness and a lot of garbage.

FLNRO staff won't deal with me on this; they have bumped me up the line to your office, hence my email to you.

I would simply request that FLNRO staff coordinate the removal of this encampment at their earliest opportunity.

Our modular housing program offers a fast and effective response to the growing issue of homelessness in communities throughout the province. This housing is made out of pre-fabricated units that can be constructed in just a few months, much quicker than constructing a new building from the ground up – which means homes are available sooner to people who really need them.

These homes are being built by skilled manufacturers here in BC that specialize in modular construction... (please fill in with a line or two about the technique – built in controlled conditions in factory, limited time needed on sites, etc).

My name is Taylor Gunn, and I lead CIVIX, a national, non-partisan civic education charity that develops that habits and skills of citizenship within students under the voting age. CIVIX coordinates experiential learning programs for elementary and secondary students that focus on electoral participation, understanding the role of elected officials, government budgets, and 'Fake News' (news literacy. We also train teachers to improve their ability to deliver our programs in their classrooms.

We are most well known for Student Vote, a parallel election program for students under the voting age. Student Vote enables students to learn about the democratic and electoral process, election issues, and political parties, before casting a ballot on the official election candidates in their school's electoral district on Student Vote Day.

In Canada's last federal election, just under 1,000,000 students cast a Student Vote ballot, from approximately half of all schools in the country.

CIVIX has a long and very successful history in BC.

We've worked in the province since 2004, and have grown our school base to nearly 70% of all schools province wide. In the recent provincial election, 160,000 students cast a Student Vote ballot.

Subject: SNG public opinion research

As discussed. We did a survey with NRG of 2000 residents region wide on a wide variety of issues in the Phase Two Plan, including SNG. The results of that survey are in Appendix A (Page 13-14) of the Phase Two Plan Public Consultation Summary Report. The relevant region-wide responses to SNG are in the first chart below.


The muni-by-muni cross-tabs, which were not released with the Report, but which are being released now, are attached. this document can be shared. See below for a chart summarizing South of Fraser respondents to the perceived importance of building SNG. Quick summary: 58% said "Extremely important or very important" to build SNG, while 12% said "Not at all important" and another 9% said "slightly important." That is pretty damn strong support! These numbers are stronger than the region-wide results because people closest to the project, who know it best and will benefit from it most, are usually more likely to say the project is important than someone who lives far from it or would never use it. Note that this sample includes drivers, not just transit users.

The Public Consultation Report also includes results from the TransLink consultation online survey which is not a representative sample – it is self-selected and allows multiple-voting.


Region-wide respondents
