I am writing in response to your emails to the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing regarding your questions on the taxing and spending authority of TransLink.

Our understanding is that you have made a recommendation to the Mayors' Council on Regional Transportation that it take legal action against TransLink on the basis that the powers provided in the *South Coast British Columbia Transportation Authority Act* are inconsistent with the *Constitution Act*. We understand that the powers that you have questioned include TransLink's ability to collect taxes, borrow funds and spend funds.

TransLink is a statutory body created by an Act of the Provincial Legislature. The Act spells out the powers and authorities for TransLink, including its authority to raise revenues, borrow and spend

funds, as well as the constraints, limitations, and expectations applicable to its revenue generation, borrowing and spending. The BC Legislature has established similar statutes for other bodies.

In your most recent email to the Minister, you requested documentation from the province's legal team. Please note that all material prepared by the province's solicitors is protected by law under solicitor – client privilege. As such any such material must not be disclosed or shared outside of government.

We would like to thank you for the information you provided. We have nothing further to add regarding the issues you have expressed.

If you are unsatisfied with the information provided to you by the Ministry on this issue, you may wish to consider contacting the Office of the Ombudsperson if you wish to pursue this matter further.
