Accessibility Proposal:

It is proposed that British Columbia adopt:

- the form and approach of the 2015 NBC, and most of its requirements;
- incorporate historical requirements from the BCBC that provide a higher level of building accessibility; and
- some requirements based on other leading standards or jurisdictions that require a higher level of accessibility in buildings.

Feedback 1:

Shawn Hagan – City of Port Coquitlam - Yes supports proposal

No comments submitted.

Feedback 2:

Jagdeep Johal – Township of Langley – No does not support proposal

I disagree with the proposed changes to align the BCBC with the NBC as there are numerous changes. I believe that the change towards NBC should be made in several smaller steps (if possible) rather than in one-step. This proposed shift will mean that the entire building industry: Architects/Local Authorities/Designers and will have to relearn this section all over again and this will generate confusion in the building industry for many years to come.

Numerous code appeals and interpretations that have been done in the past will not have any relevance, as the approach to accessibility is changing. If we are to stay with our current BCBC approach to accessibility with many revisions proposed amendments included that will give the industry more time to gradually change to NBC model or similar outcome without changing code approach to accessibility. Another concern with the change of code language is related to new work in existing buildings. If the base building was constructed under previous code and any new work (renovations – tenant improvements) have to conform to this new approach 2018 BCBC for accessibility, this will generate a lot of confusion and will not result in a building that conforms to either existing or the new code requirements.

Code clause deletion of current 3.8.2.3.(2) (b): “where the occupant load of the building or occupancy exceeds 150, other public washrooms in floor areas required to be accessible shall conform to Sentences 3.7.2.10.(2) to (8).” Will require accessible stalls in smaller buildings and smaller units (ie: restaurants), thus taking away from retail area that may be challenging to developers and retailers in utilizing their space.

General Comments:

I want to thank the Building and safety standards branch for reorganizing Accessibility requirements. There are a numerous changes in the revisions that will give more clarity of the code intent. Proposed changes will be good for any new users as they won't have much experience with current version and will not have to change conceptual understanding.

Thank you Andy for taking the time to answer a few of my questions through this review process.

Dan Lecours – Greater Vancouver Association for the Deaf – No

Requested meeting to discuss code changes in person, with a sign language interpreter.

Do not accept having impairment word – change to deaf or hard of hearing words.

Do not like signs for assisted listening facilities to change (this?) sign or sign language assistance sign or video relay service sign.

General Comments:

Building / Condo for communication system door ring – no voice use video communication door also add new flash light for telephone ring or door ring and plus new camera video.

Please set up a meeting you and bring a sign language interpreter. I will explain more. Please email s.22

Feedback 5:

Pam Horton – Disability Alliance of BC – Yes supports proposal

To the best of my ability to read this document, I support what I have read.

Feedback 6:

Wendy Morrison – GHl Consultants – Yes supports with suggested changed

Elimination of specific provisions in Articles 3.8.2.3 to 3.8.2.36 and will result in confusion of application of accessibility requirements throughout all buildings. For example, 3.8.2.3 currently qualifies access is only required to areas where work functions can reasonably be expected to be performed by persons with disabilities; for Jails, 3.8.2.24 waives application of 3.8.2.3 and generally requires access to visitor areas only. Under proposed changes it appears that access is required throughout all areas of jails. From our experience the BCBC waivers are useful in various occupancies where work functions are not reasonably expected to be performed by persons with disabilities; hospitals (care staff); bowling alleys

(pin setters); tool rental, shipping or warehouse centers (access for public areas only); restaurant kitchens.

General Comments:

Sentence 3.8.2.1.(2) - elimination of waiver for access to Group E shops and stores with a total retail floor space of less than 50m² will have significant effect on existing buildings and pose a significant cost to tenants moving into existing small shops. As with many Code provisions for existing buildings this could result in a base building renovation cost being applied to a tenant (who has already signed a lease) at the time of tenant improvement BP without opportunity to negotiate, with the landlord or building owner, the cost of the required renovation to provide access to the suite .

Regarding accessibility provisions apply at washrooms - there is no definition of washroom and where it applies - will this require all jail, hospital, and care facility sleeping room bathrooms to meet accessible design criteria? Does this apply to washrooms in buildings designated for public use only? Will it apply to a private bathroom installed within a private office within a larger office occupancy with public washrooms?

Feedback 7:

Joanne Pocock – Interior Designers Institute of BC – Yes supports with suggested changes

We have several comments / quires regarding specific line items proposed for change - please see the attached document.

In general we feel that increased clearances for accessibility purposes are a step in the right direction but really want to see these changes put forth in a clear and straight-forward manner. Updating the Accessibility Handbook to match all the criteria of the new code is critical.

Page 1: 1.4.1.2. 1)

Defined term “Adaptable dwelling unit...” has changes noted, but the wording remains same. So there no need for changes.

Page 2: 3.1.1.2. 3)a)

While certain types of dwelling units have been deleted from this clause, it would be helpful if “dwelling units” was a defined term in 1.4.1.2. and the deleted terms were included in the definition as applicable.

Page 2: 3.1.1.2. 3)b)

Would “multi-unit residential” be more definitive than “Apartment and condominium buildings...”? “Multi-unit residential” could also be a defined term in 1.4.1.2.

Page 3: 3.2.1.1.

Consider “...persons with disabilities...” only, as “sensory disability” is included in 1.4.1.2. Defined Terms “Persons with disabilities...” .

Page 3: 3.2.4.19. 1)

Access Feedback

Consider adding clause 3.2.4.19. 1)e) single occupancy washrooms in Group D and E occupancies.

Page 5: 3.3.1.7. 1)

This clause may be problematic in alterations to existing buildings. Consider including acceptable solutions should it not be possible to achieve this in alterations to existing buildings.

Page 5: 3.3.1.7 4) c)

Again, this clause may be problematic in alterations to existing buildings. Consider including acceptable solutions should it not be possible to achieve this in alterations to existing buildings. Also, is there a need to require a threshold of 13 mm or less to balconies off accessible sleeping rooms and bed spaces?

Page 8: 3.4.6.8. 11)b) and 11)c)

Why are “exit stairs not normally used for access purposes” and “fire escape stairs” not required to have tactile warning surface indicators?

Page 8: Boxed paragraph below 3.4.6.8. 11)c)

“It is recommended that the requirements for tactile walking surface indicators be expanded to include multi-unit residential buildings.” Assume this is referring to stairs outside dwelling units?

Page 11: 3.7.2.7. 1)

This clause may be problematic in alterations to existing buildings. Consider including acceptable solutions should it not be possible to achieve this in alterations to existing buildings.

Page 12: 3.8.1

What triggers accessibility upgrades in alterations to existing buildings?

Page 13: 3.8.2.1. 1)

Would “multi-unit residential” be more definitive than “Apartment and condominium buildings...”? “Multi-unit residential” could also be a defined term in 1.4.1.2..

Page 14: 3.8.2.3. 1)

This clause may be problematic in alterations to existing buildings. Consider including acceptable solutions should it not be possible to achieve this in alterations to existing buildings.

Page 15: Table 3.8.2.3.

To be clearer, consider adding “above 501 seats” at the end of “501–5000...6, plus one additional space for each 150 or part thereof”. Refer table below.

To be clearer, consider adding “above 5001 seats” at the end of “5001 and over...36, plus one additional space for each 200 or part thereof”. Refer table below.

Number of Fixed Seats in Seating Area Number of Spaces Required for Wheelchairs

501 – 5000 6, plus one additional space for each 150 or part thereof

above 501 seats 5001 and over 36, plus one additional space for each 200 or part thereof above 5001 seats.

Page 16: 3.8.2.6. 1)

Unable to find clause 3.5.2.1. (3) referenced in Accessibility Appendix 1.

Page 16: 3.8.2.7

Consider power door operators be required at entries to accessible washrooms in Group A, B and D occupancies, or suggested for improved independence of wheelchair users.

Page 19: 3.8.2.11.

Access Feedback

Is “Counters for Telephones” and “public telephones” referring to pay phones or phones for public use? Pay phones are no longer installed in new buildings.

Page 21 and 22: 3.8.3.2.

Changing widths may be problematic in alterations to existing buildings. Consider including acceptable solutions should it not be possible to achieve this in alterations to existing buildings. Consider adding clause with requirements for 1500 mm clear turning radius in corridors where there is a change of direction and outside accessible washrooms.

Page 23: 3.8.3.5. 1)a)ii) and 3.8.3.5. 1)a)iii)

Is “6 m or less” referring to the length of the ramp? Clear width is already noted to be 915 mm.

Page 27: 3.8.3.10.

Bottle fillers are more commonly used, yet they are not mentioned, nor is an accessible height be indicated. Bottle filling stations are referenced in A-3.8.2.8.(9).

Page 29: 3.8.3.12.

Increasing universal washroom dimensions may be problematic in alterations to existing buildings. Consider including acceptable solutions should it not be possible to achieve this in alterations to existing buildings.

Page 29: 3.8.3.12.1) h)

Consider adding more details for shelf requirements, such as minimum dimensions, surface mount or recessed.

Page 29: 3.8.3.12 1)

Consider adding clause 3.8.3.12 1)j) “have auto lighting controls and provide lighting on an emergency circuit”.

Page 33: 3.8.3.20.

Refer comments in Page 19: 3.8.2.11.

Page 36: 3.8.4.7.

In many instances, the washrooms are building common and not part of alteration scope. What would trigger the building owner to make upgrades to washrooms to meet the 2018 BCBC Accessibility Appendix 1 requirements?

Page 40: boxed text below A-3.8. Yes, we fully agree that the Building Access Handbook needs to be updated to encompass all requirements in the forthcoming 2018 BCBC Accessibility Appendix 1. Updated illustrations would be very helpful. The Building Access Handbook 2014 does not incorporate all the requirements and leads to confusion.

Page 43: A-3.8.2.6. (2)

Do “Electrical outlets intended for occupant use...” include electric vehicle charging stations and block heater plugs in outlets at accessible parking spaces?

Page 44: A-3.8.3.2. (2)

“...walk-off matts...installed and securely fixed...”

What would be considered securely fixed walk-off matts that are removable for off-site cleaning?

Guillaume Dufresne - Accessibility Secretariat – Yes supports proposal with suggested changes

Feedback 9:

Diane Tarchuck – Ministry of Children and Family Development – SL marked as yes with suggested changes as not indicated in response

1. Page 3: Visible Signal Devices and Visible Warning Systems (3.2.4.19)
 - a). Door buzzer for getting into condo or apartment buildings – often Deaf people will just press on the button and try to feel the “click” that opens the door (we would “shake” the door handle to ensure it gets open and people would assume we’re trying to break the door 😊). How about adding a monitor screen in the door entry area in every building so Deaf people can view the signal that someone is answering or the door is buzzing?
 - b). Add a small screen in elevators in an event of emergency as Deaf and hard of hearing people can’t hear voice announcements
2. Page 43: Signs and Indicators (A-2.8.3.9(1)-A)
 - a). Information on TTY is fine but it is an old fashioned phone device and Deaf people are moving on to a current, modern and visualized phone device. But, leave that information for now but suggest to add Video Relay Services (recently launched this past September) which is an internet-based phone communication between Deaf and Hard of Hearing people using American Sign Language (ASL) or French Sign Language (LSQ) and hearing people who do not use ASL or LSQ. However, Video Relay Services requires high –speed internet connection through a computer, tablet or smartphone. Hi Jerry,

Andy is s.22 today and he confirms what my eyes were seeing last week.

Regarding accessible parking stalls, the content of the next Code is not decided yet. However, we CAN tell you what is going out for public review.

The proposal is that the BC Building Code will follow the National Building Code model. The proposed 2018 BCBC will be silent on accessible parking stalls. All of the parking stall requirements currently located in Article 3.8.3.4. will be gone.

The *Building Act* lists “parking stalls for persons with disabilities” as an unrestricted matter. This opens the door for local governments to make all the decisions/rules about these stalls, including size, number, and etc.

We'll see what kind of feedback we get from the public review phase, but that is the current direction.

By the way, the National Code DOES regulate passenger drop-off zones, and it is proposed that the next BCBC will have something similar.

As mentioned in the Access Handbook that for this type of situation, consideration to a min. 4.7m width stall should be thought of rather than being the min. requirement as per 3.8.3.4.- Our Planning Department in their wisdom have revised their Zoning Parking requirements to reflect back to meeting the current BCBC for this scenario.

Be good to know if this is in the change for the up and coming new code cycle. If not I may have to have a sit down with the planning department to factor this into their design guidelines for rezoning and such.

We are getting many complaints from Van owners the stalls will not accommodate this type- understandable –

Hello Jag,

I may be missing something with the example here, but I will offer that it is Subsection 2.2.7. of Division C, not Subsection 2.2.2., that prescribes when a professional is required. (Also, there is the Architects Act and the Engineers and Geoscientists Act that prescribe what work requires a professional.) Further, the line items on the Schedules do not themselves trigger the requirement for a professional. Rather when a professional is required by Subsection 2.2.7., the professional must take responsibility for the line items.

With regards to a tenant improvement of an existing building, if the alteration is to a building that meets the descriptions in Sentence 2.2.7.1.(1), the owner must retain a professional. The alteration may not affect the building envelope, but the professional is still required.

Subsection 2.2.2. applies separately, or independently, from Subsection 2.2.7. Meaning, if the building (to be altered or new) is *not* described in Sentence 2.2.7.1.(1), it does *not* have to be a professional who submits the information described in Subsection 2.2.2. This is from a Building Code perspective and there may be local authorities who have additional administrative requirements for professional involvement over and above those of the Code.

My opinion is that if a designer provides all of the required information as indicated on Division C – Part 2 (2.2.2.). Building code compliance is illustrated on plans for a design (including but not limited to: fire separation, fire resistance assemblies, closures and egress requirements, etc.), then an Architect or Professional engineer will not be required for **tenant improvement works**. My question is relation to interior works only (No environmental separations and building envelope scope involved in this scenario).

Hi Andy,

Thanks for including me in the review process.

Building and safety standards branch has put a lot of work to reorganize Accessibility requirements. It will surely make it easier for any new users to the code, and educators.

I have the following questions pertaining to the revisions after my initial cursory review of the revisions:

- I didn't find the 3.8.2.3.(2) b) of 2012 BCBC clause included in the proposed revisions: "where the occupant load of the building or occupancy exceeds 150, other public washrooms in floor areas required to be accessible shall conform to Sentences 3.7.2.10.(2) to (8)." Due to this deletion it appears that new requirements for washrooms in buildings with lesser than 150 people occupant will also need to comply with accessible washroom requirements? Does this also mean that any time the occupant load exceeds 10 people – requiring washrooms in excess of one universal washroom those washrooms will need to be accessible as well? Please confirm whether that is correct.

The approach to assigning washrooms is taken from the National Building Code which is *generally*; 1 on the entrance storey, 1 on each accessible storey, and 1 in a washroom with multiple stalls/fixtures. The BC requirement for a universal washroom as being the 'first' washroom required is continued. The NBC uses accessible floors and multiple-stall-washrooms to dictate what is to be provided, less so occupant load.

- Can you please comment whether the occupancy specific requirements "3.8.2.4.-3.8.2.39. of the current BCBC" will be carried over to the new code?

The Articles are not carried over in the format of the 2012 BCBC. The NBC approach is to assign access requirements based on occupancy (more general) rather than acutely (right down to business venture...). The application in the draft Subsection 3.8.2. is to capture the gamut of *what should be accessible based on the occupancy* such as path of travel, viewing positions, facilities, connections to parking, signage, etc. –which replaces the requirements within 2012 BCBC Articles 3.8.2.4. to 3.8.2.39.

- 3.8.2.8.(10 & 11) of the proposed revisions will result in stricter requirements than the current code. Is that the intention?

The NBC contains the provisions which are adopted by many Canadian jurisdictions. The next BCBC is to align with the NBC which, in a number of instances such as this, result in increased accessibility requirements.

- Is the clause 3.8.2.3.(1) (C) of the BCBC 2012 deleted? If yes then will this not lessen the existing requirements? Currently I require that the architects/designers show/provide access to common facilities in private offices due to this clause of the code.

See Sentence 3.8.2.3.(1) of the draft. BC's intention of 'throughout' is to extend access requirements to all areas where persons with disabilities could work or visit. (Which is the same as in the 2012 BCBC.) There are some exceptions for where services are duplicated on an accessible floor area. If there is no provision for the 'office work' to be done in an accessible space and such 'office work' can be done by persons with disabilities, then the space should be accessible.

- 3.8.3.6.(11) (C) is a good additions to the code. We discussed this scenario in past at our staff meetings and at the LMTC meeting. I am a bit confused about clause (d) can you please provide a rough sketch?

(11)(d) requires that *of* the total clear space, an amount should be provided around the latching side. It is intended to create illustrations for the Appendix, although that has not been completed for the draft. There are illustrations in the CSA B651 standard which may be helpful.

- I think that the proposed relocation of the accessible parking stall requirements will make the buildings less accessible as the requirement will only be in the appendix and won't be easily enforceable (if the local government doesn't have additional requirements)



The National Codes stay out of parking other than the connection to the building. This draft relies on local authorities to manage this issue to suit their need using their existing authorities to do so. Many local authorities have parking bylaws that are far more in-depth than the provisions of the 2012 BCBC. There are many local considerations for parking and fewer direct links to Code objectives.

- 3.8.2.3.(2)(k) of the proposed revision indicates, “within a suite of residential occupancy that has not been designated by an authority having jurisdiction to be accessible”. Is this refereeing to adaptable units? If yes, then should it not only indicate adaptable units?

This is NBC content and is not specific or limited to adaptable dwelling units. This could be a suite of residential occupancy that is not a dwelling unit (which is exempted per draft Clause 3.8.2.1.(1)(a)). Requiring access is greater than requiring adaptability.

Please contact me if you find any of my comments to be confusing.

Hello Wayne,

Please accept my apologies for such a late response. I do hope the new year is finding you well!

I must be honest that I find it unclear as to what all is meant to be captured by Sentence 3.8.3.4.(2). One might read that Sentence (1) discusses Group C and Group A occupancies so Sentence (2) therefor must apply to all Bs, Ds, Es, F1s and F2s. I find this to be an incomplete interpretation as there could be As without fixed seats or even visitor spots for residential buildings that *should* be provided with accessible stalls.

Another reading might be that Sentence (2) is to apply to *other than required-to-be-accessible sleeping units and other than required-to-be-accessible viewing positions*, leaving all parking for buildings within the scope of 3.8. (i.e. *not* F1s) as requiring 1 in 50 stalls to be accessible. This could play out that a residential club with sleeping accommodation for 8 persons (less than 10 so no accessible sleeping provisions are triggered) provides 1 accessible parking stall for every 50. Or, a community hall with no fixed seating provides 1 accessible parking stall for every 50. I believe this would be a good-faith demonstration of the intent, even if the language does not make this clear.

With how confusing the language in Article 3.8.3.4. is, I'm surprised this has not come up more often. I'm betting this is often managed by local parking bylaws which have kept the spotlight off this article.

From projections I have heard for the number/percentage of persons with mobility challenges expected in 2030, 2040, etc. I do hope that designers are allocating far more than 1 in 50 stalls to offer greater access. (One source [here](#).) I suppose I'm only deflecting to say that if far more stalls were provided than the minimum, we could avoid figuring out just what the minimum is, but there you have it.

Are you required to have accessible parking for a residential building of any size or number of units if there are no sleeping units that conform to 3.8.3.14 as in 3.8.3.4(1)?

My thinking is that you have to defer to 3.8.3.4(2) because if not then you could essentially have an assembly occupancy with 499 viewing positions that would require no accessible parking stalls.
