It was a pleasure presenting at the BCSEA event a couple of weeks ago alongside you and several other organizations. I was honored to be able to present and add the perspective of the private industry to the challenges facing the regional transportation system. Together with my partners, Jonathan Whitworth and Arturo Miguel, cc'ed in this email, we applaud the efforts of the BC Government to tackle the transportation challenges of our region.

As you might know, Cowlines, a multimodal mobility platform and app, launched last week

across Metro Vancouver and the Fraser Valley. We would like to present our platform in detail to you, as we believe it can greatly contribute to the efforts that the region is making to reduce congestion and pollution related to passenger transport. Cowlines does two simple things: it helps people move faster without cars and helps them reduce their carbon footprint.

Cowlines is now available for free in the app store: https://apple.co/2QamrBh. In the Lower Mainland, Cowlines currently integrates 8 local service providers:

- TransLink
- West Coast Express
- BC Transit
- · Mobi bikes
- Modo Car Coop
- · Aquabus Ferries
- False Creek Ferries
- Taxicabs (all 35 operators).

Cowlines provides users with key information in their trip planning efforts, providing door-to-door information on travel time, total cost and even verifiable CO2 emissions. It also displays a side-by-side comparison to an equivalent private vehicle trip, so users are aware of the total cost (Total Cost of Ownership), time and emissions that a vehicle trip would entail.

Greenlines has developed, working together with BC Ministry of Environment, Climate Action Secretariat and Metro Vancouver, a leading GHG Quantification and Modal Shift Optimization methodology for passenger transport. It enables transportation providers as well as Governments to track and report on achieved GHG emissions reductions in the diverse transportation sector. By doing so, it opens up the opportunity for a cost-effective evaluation of transportation solutions towards strategic GHG emission reductions targets in the transportation sector.

We are currently very active both nationally and internationally, including participation in the Smart Cities Challenge with the City of Vancouver/Surrey and the City of Victoria, a potential partnership with TransLink and BC Transit, as well as potential agreements with governments from Honolulu, New Delhi, Jakarta, Queretaro, and others. The European Commission and the World Economic Forum have expressed interest to explore collaborations and launch in selected markets. During October, we will expand to Seattle and Portland, and in the next months, Cowlines will be available in 10 major cities in North America. I attach the results of the pilot program we launched back in March.

We would like to meet with you when your agenda allows to discuss possible avenues of collaboration and how our organization can improve congestion and pollution in our region. Both Jonathan and I are available next week.
