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BACKGROUND:

The Class 8 designation generally provides substantial property tax savings over the higher Class 6 (Business and Other) rates that would otherwise apply. A breakdown of properties by assessment area is included in Appendix 1.

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It is important to note that assessment valuation is based on highest and best use (usually tied to future redevelopment to residential or commercial according to the zoning), but classification for taxation purposes is typically tied to current use. § 13
