Dear Ms. Guzon,

This email is a follow up to the message sent by Valerie Amante regarding the visit of Premier Christy Clark of the Province of British Columbia, Canada to Manila later this month.

Thank you again for confirming the attendance of Mr. Tanmantiong at the luncheon on May 27th at ^{s.15} Makati.

I would like to inquire about the possibility of Premier Clark and Mr. Tanmantiong meeting prior to the luncheon. Premier Clark knows that many Canadians, including the large British Columbian population of Philippine descent, are excited by the prospect of a Jollibee restaurant opening in Canada – and in Vancouver in particular. One way to highlight this development would be to take a photo of Mr. Tanmantiong and the Premier in front of a Jollibee restaurant. The Premier would distribute the photo through the government's news and social media accounts and Jollibee could do the same, of course.

If Mr. Tanmantiong is available, and this is of interest, we would appreciate your insight on what Jollibee location would be most convenient. The Premier will be in ^{s.15}

^{s.15} for meetings until 11:00AM. The luncheon begins at 12PM so that leaves a period of time for a photo and discussion prior to lunch. Perhaps the Premier and Mr. Tanmantiong can travel from the restaurant to the luncheon at ^{s.15} together which will allow for some time for discussion.

I have copied my colleagues at the Embassy of Canada and British Columbia Office in Manila as they are best placed to follow up on the logistical arrangements. Mr. Michel Belanger is Senior Trade Commissioner; Ms. Angel Cachuela is Trade Commissioner, and Ms. Eva Yazon is Managing Director of the British Columbia Representative Office.
